Recipes

HERE'S A GOOD ONE

Did you ever taste hot chicken salad? It's easy to make with chopped cooked chicken. Combine the chicken with chopped green onion, celery, pimiento and wedges of the olives. Blend with cooked salad dressing. Place in individual baking dishes, cover with crushed corn flakes and bake in very hot oven (450 F.) 15 minutes.

SHORT AND SWEET

Try this quick dessert on your family and watch them ask you to serve it again and again. Stick canned cling peach halves with a few whole cloves and place in a shallow baking dish. Combine 3/4 cup peach syrup with 1/4 cup molasses, 2 tablespoons melted butter and 1 tablespoon lemon juice. Pour over peaches and bake in moderate oven 15 to 20 minutes. Serve warm with whipped cream.

TRY THIS

Appetizers are a wonderful remedy for indigestion. Often, however, appetizers are too much on the elaborate side and instead of stimulating appetites, they do just the opposite. To put a nice edge on the appetite combine this congenial threesome: 1 1/2 cups apricot whole fruit nectar, 1/2 cup pineapple juice and lime juice to taste. Chill well before serving.

EASY TO FIX

Canned fruit cocktail is one of the most popular and versatile of all canned fruits. It may be varied in ever so many ways. Add some of the fresh autumn fruits like unpeeled apple to give crispness, cubed papaya to give distinction, or melon balls to give pleasing texture — the cocktail never becomes tiresome with seasonal variations.

thrust violet, ice blue, sky blue, cobalt, ruby, coral, orange, amethyst, brown and burgundy are other exquisite glass colors.

With colored glass as a starting point, it is easy to create a lovely table. Here are 10 color plans for table settings:

10 COLOR SCHEMES
1. Repeat the soft glow of sky-blue glass in a blue and white striped table cloth and napkins. Use white dishes with meadow flower borders. For a centerpiece, a wicker basket of field flowers.
2. For a bright buffet: Ruby red tumblers. Table cover cut from a length of white muslin; or white linoleum cut to the exact size of the table top. Floor in white pottery or earthenware bowls, platters and tureens, standing on black or red tiles. On a side table, white cups, saucers and coffee pot on red mats; red apples in white bowl.

3. With spruce green glass: plaid cloth in tawny tans, browns; pine green napkins; pale green and white earthenware dishes; natural wood bowl of ivy and autumn zinnias in gold and yellow tones.

4. With driftwood, cinnamon or tobacco brown glassware, here is a table for a modern room: moss green cloth, mustard gold napkins; simple white china; centerpiece of gold, white and tangerine flowers; pale green grapes.

5. With amethyst stemware: natural linen cloth or mats, purple napkins; dishes in pink-mauve-beige coloring; centerpiece of pink, white, purple asters.

BLACK AND WHITE
6. Set off the white of milk glass against a black linen cloth and napkins. Chartreuse dishes. Centerpieces of lemons and limes piled in bowl rimmed with sprays of glossy laurel or huckleberry.

7. With ripe olive brown glassware: rust mats and napkins; royal blue and beige pottery dishes. Centerpiece: copper bowl of bronze chrysanthemums, zinnias or other autumn flowers and foliage.

8. With amber glass: chartreuse mats, brown napkins. White china with pimiento red borders. Centerpiece, pine boughs, cattails or laurel with bunches of green grape.

9. With smoke-gray glass: dark gray cloth or mats and napkins; charcoal gray dishes. Centerpiece: brilliant red roses, geraniums, carnations or other available blooms.

10. With cobalt glass: cloth and napkins of dusty rose and gray-blue. China repeating colors in tabcloth. Centerpiece: cluster of bronze or gilt figurines, ornaments or candlesticks.

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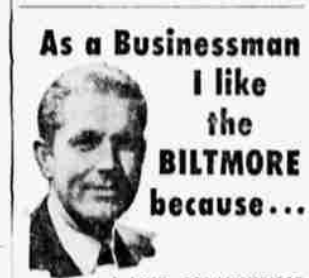
Honey For Sweetenin' Gives Energy

Do you like honey spread on bread and butter, honey over the breakfast cereal, honey used in place of sugar in baking and desserts? If you do, here's good news—there is an abundant supply on hand now.

HONEY DROP COOKIES
One-fourth cup butter, 1 egg, beaten, 3/4 cup honey, 2 tablespoons milk, 2 cups sifted flour, 2 teaspoons baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1 cup chopped nuts, 1/2 cup chopped dates, figs or other dried fruits, 1/2 cup chopped candied citron or pineapple.
Cream the butter. Mix the beaten egg, honey and milk. Add the ingredients and add alternately with the liquid to the butter. Drop by small spoonfuls on a greased baking sheet and bake in a moderately hot oven (375 degrees F.) for about 10 minutes.

NEW BOBBY PINS
New bobby pins have been especially treated for use with home permanent wave solutions. Hereafter, some bobby pins were likely to change the color of the solution or leave marks on light gray hair.

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HONEY NUT BREAD
One-half cup coarsely chopped nuts, 2 cups flour, 3 teaspoons baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1 egg, beaten, 1/2 cup honey, 1/2 cup milk, 2 tablespoons melted butter.
Add the nuts to the sifted dry ingredients. Combine the beaten egg, honey, milk and melted butter, and add to the first mixture. Stir until the ingredients are just moistened. Bake in a greased bread pan in a moderate oven (350 degrees F.) for 45 to 50 minutes.

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
