Sparkman Doubts Influence of Nixon Fund Controversy

WASHINGTON (AP)—Sen. John Sparkman says he doubts the "Nixon fund" controversy will have any great impact on the Nov. 4 presidential election.

"I personally would not," he said. He had never had a fund of any kind, not even a campaign fund. He said he has managed to save money each year since 1936, when he first was elected to the House. He moved to the Senate in 1946.

As soon as he can find time, Sparkman said, he will release a breakdown of his income for the past 10 years, as Gov. Stevenson did yesterday. An article in yesterday's New York Times, Sparkman added, gives a general picture of his financial status.

West Powers Mull Austria

LONDON (AP)—Deputy foreign ministers of the Big Three Western Powers meet again today to see what can be done about an Austrian independence treaty despite Russia's refusal to attend the conference.

Diplomats here privately suggested that the deadlock was due more to the cold war itself than to any inability to agree on the terms of a treaty. This view was supported by Austrian government officials, who unofficially indicated they believe Russia has no desire to get out of the country and no intention of doing so in the foreseeable future.

Prospects for a solution to the six-year impasse were not bright. In rejecting the invitation to the meeting, the Soviets indicated they were standing pat on terms they have held to throughout the protracted negotiations.

Dispatches from Moscow said hopes for any agreement between the Soviet Union and the West
