

Linfield, Whitworth In Feature Grid Tiff

A Linfield team that started the football season with a three-victory rush slams into Whitworth this week in one of the northwest's small college headline battles.

While these clubs are wrangling Saturday at McMinnville, Ore., Eastern Washington College—one of the Linfield victims—will take on Montana State at Bozeman.

Willamette and College of Puget Sound will get the week off to a hot start in Tacoma Friday night in what could be the best of the intersectionals. C. P. S. has beaten Pacific Lutheran and lost to Western Washington in its two starts, in both cases by one-touchdown margins. Willamette crushed Chico State of California 53-0 in its only outing.

League action in the Northwest and Evergreen conferences will be confined to Saturday. Away in front by its decision over Puget

Sound, Western will invade Tacoma to tackle the Lions, only aggregation it bowed to last year in Evergreen play. P. L. C. has lost to C. P. S. and Humboldt State this season by a total count of 14 to 0.

Central Washington battles British Columbia in Vancouver in round out the conference week.

The defending champ of the Northwest circuit, Lewis and Clark, meets Whitman on a neutral field at Bend, Ore. Pacific, ambitious to head its own league after opening with a 9-7 decision over Western, meets College of Idaho at Caldwell.

KASRU Lists Hunter Rules

The Klamath Air Search and Rescue Unit wants to make lost hunters easier to find. In the Wednesday night KASRU meeting, Hal Ogle, director of the Klamath Forest Protective Association, was requested to draw up some rules for hunters, who become lost. Ogle added some rules for safe hunting.

Here is Ogle's code:

If you become lost or injured remember that within 24 hours there will be a widespread search. Don't play hide-and-seek with the searchers. Stay where you are and build a safe fire. Put some green boughs on the fire occasionally to make a heavy white smoke.

Don't travel after dark.

If you find a road, stay on it for all roads will be searched first.

Don't walk very far with wet feet. It will cause blisters and may result in an infection.

If your hunting shoes haven't been worn for some time, the in-

soles may have curled and may cause blisters. Before putting on the shoes, pack them with damp newspaper for a few hours to soften the leather.

Don't build warming fires.

Don't shoot until you see the game.

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Return Of Bonus Rule Seen

NEW YORK (AP) — The major leagues probably will restore the old bonus rule this winter, with a few extra teeth.

Frank Lane, general manager of the Chicago White Sox who heads a committee to investigate the bonus setup and propose a rule, said Friday his group is ready to recommend the return of the statute which was dropped two years ago.

"But this one will have teeth," Lane said.

The bonus committee will recommend bonuses to newly signed players be limited to \$6,000 a year, including salary. There would be no limit on the length of the contract.

Violation of the rule, under this provision, would call for a fine of \$500 against the offending club, loss of rights to the player involved and a year's suspension for the club official responsible for breaking the statute.

The major league owners will consider this recommendation at their winter meetings in Phoenix, Ariz., in December.



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
