

Psychologist Tells Test For Finding Perfect Wife

HOLLYWOOD (AP)—Are you a perfect wife?

Chances are, you come closer to being a perfect mate than your husband. A psychologist says that the man is more often at fault in imperfect marriages.

The expert is Dr. Mason Rose, Ph.D., who is advising on a film with the hopeful title of "Dream Wife." He remarked that dream wives are more common than dream husbands.

"That doesn't mean that women are never at fault," he added. "But in my interviews on marital relations, I have found that the wives are more anxious to make

marriage work than the husbands. Generally the woman is willing to conform to the man's wishes, if he knows what he wants."

The trouble with many U. S. marriages, Dr. Rose said, is that the men maintain an 18th century belief in the status of women.

"Most men don't want their wives to work," he said. "They feel that their children can't be properly reared by a working mother."

"But a high-energy type of woman shouldn't be limited to being a housewife. Furthermore, surveys of primitive tribes in the South Pacific, where there is little child guidance, show a lack of neuroses and crime. It is highly regulated children who get neuroses. The only things children need are to be loved and to be wanted."

The perfect mates, he commented, are those who view marriage as "a fellowship of wills. Husband and wife must have equal rights and help each other," he said.

Dr. Rose offered a test to determine whether you are a perfect wife. Here are the questions:

1. Are you troubled because your husband differs from you in beliefs and standards?
 2. Do you feel there are serious disadvantages to being married?
 3. Do you have a better time with someone other than your husband?
 4. Do you discuss intimate personal matters with your parents, relatives or friends?
 5. Do you feel your husband does not consult you regarding important decisions?
 6. Do you feel rebellious against or bored with your household duties?
 7. Are you critical of your husband's small faults?
 8. Are you easily upset when things go wrong?
 9. Is your household budget usually in the red?
 10. Do you know other wives who are better treated than you?
 11. If a family quarrel occurs, do you use past disagreements as a weapon against your husband?
 12. Do you feel that your husband is less attractive and successful than the husbands of your friends?
 13. Would you like to be younger than you are?
 14. Do you find it difficult to be a good mixer at parties?
 15. Do you feel your marital responsibilities keep you tied down too much?
- If you can answer "no" to 10 of the questions, you're a good wife. If your score is higher, take a bow.

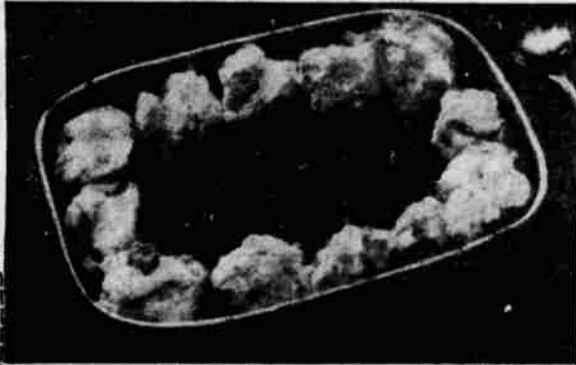

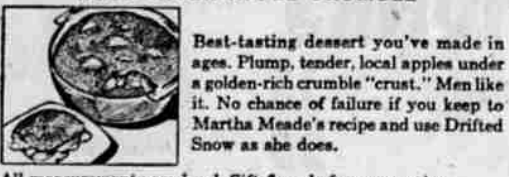

HOOD RIVER APPLE CRUMBLE



Best-tasting dessert you've made in ages. Plump, tender, local apples under a golden-rich crumble "crust." Men like it. No chance of failure if you keep to Martha Meade's recipe and use Drifted Snow as she does.

All measurements are level. Sift flour before measuring into a buttered baking dish (8 or 9-inch square or 1 1/2-quart round) thinly slice—

- 3 or 4 large apples, peeled and cored

Cheese Crumble

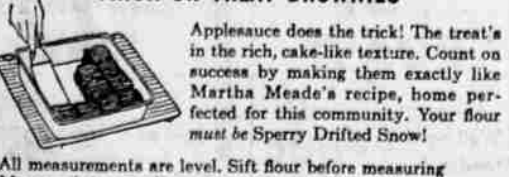
Stir together—

- 1 cup sifted Sperry Drifted Snow "Home-Perfected" Enriched Flour

- 1/2 cup shortening

- 1/2-1/2 cup whole egg, (2 large)
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 cup very thick applesauce (sweetened or unsweetened)

Beat until ingredients are well blended. Then sift together—

- 1 teaspoon double-action baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt

Add to chocolate mixture, along with—

- 1/2 cup nuts, chopped

Mix to a smooth batter. Turn into a greased and floured square pan, 9x9x2 inches. Bake in a preheated moderate oven, 350°, for 25 to 30 minutes, or just until done. Turn out on wire cake rack to cool thoroughly before cutting into squares or bars. About 3 dozen small squares.

SISTERS SPOONBURGER CASSEROLE

All measurements are level. Sift flour before measuring in a heated skillet (9 or 10-inch diameter) place—

- 2 tablespoons drippings, or cooking oil
- 1 large onion, sliced
- 1 pound ground beef (2 cups)

Fry until meat is browned and onion soft. Add—

- 1 cup tomato hot sauce (8 oz. can)
- 1 cup water
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon mustard (dry or prepared)
- 1 teaspoon chili powder
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 cup sweet pickle relish

Stir to blend ingredients, then bring to a boil. Turn into a 1 1/2 or 2-quart casserole (or, use skillet in which mixture is cooking). Drop small spoonfuls of Stir-N-Roll Biscuit Topping around edge of casserole over hot mixture. Bake in a preheated hot oven, 425°, for 20 to 25 minutes, or until topping is baked and nicely browned. To serve: place a biscuit on dinner plate and spoon "burger" mixture over top. 6 servings.

Sift together into a mixing bowl—
