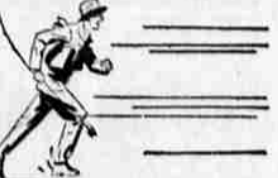

TRUTH! Not BUNK—

ABOUT THE MILK BILL!

Here is what the OREGONIAN said after careful consideration of ALL FACTS.....

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11, 1952 Voters who may be puzzled if not alarmed by the violence of the milk control argument should take comfort in the fact that under 18 years of state regulation Oregon markets have continued, in season and out, to provide an adequate supply of GOOD MILK for the babies, at REASONABLE PRICES.

The Oregonian has been an occasional critic of administrative practices of the various milk control agencies and directors. But WE OPPOSED REPEAL of the milk control act in 1948, when the people voted to retain it by a slim margin of 12,000 ballots.

In our opinion, the PUBLIC INTEREST WILL BE SERVED BY REJECTION OF THE INITIATIVE PROPOSAL to substitute a skeletonized version of milk control—leaving only the dubious protection of minimum prices to producers—for the present law requiring minimum prices at all levels, farmer, distributor and retailer, and establishing producers' quotas which assure a stable supply of milk at all times.

Instead of destroying the law, the critics of milk administration practices should demand that the next legislature amend the act to remedy its faults. THE PRESENT LAW, FOR EXAMPLE, AUTHORIZES ESTABLISHMENT OF A STOPE DIFFERENTIAL—A LOWER PRICE AT A STORE THAN ON THE DOORSTEP. But the milk marketing administration stubbornly has refused to grant it.

Before so many people got so angry about it, the store differential was the principal issue. The housewives' lobby, now represented by the Affiliated Milk committee, and some chain stores—notably Safeway—were after a one-cent differential. At one time, the legislature appeared to be about ready to give way on the point, then got its back up. The assembly has authorized several changes of administrative agencies without getting at the real complaints.

Opposition to milk control has been encouraged, also, by arbitrary actions of the milk administrators, who have declined to permit reasonable competition within the framework of the law. MILK UNFORTUNATELY, HAS BEEN GRABBED AS A POLITICAL ISSUE, AND THIS HAS UNNECESSARILY DIVIDED CITY AND COUNTRY AND KEPT HOUSEWIVES AND A \$70,000,000 OREGON INDUSTRY IN TURMOIL.

A sensible approach to the question of milk control is recognition that milk is a commodity deserving special treatment. We have always considered milk to be in a class by itself, meriting semi-public utility protection in the interests of consumers. And there is no protection for consumers if producers, distributors or small retailers could be torpedoed—any of these groups.

THE INITIATIVE CAMPAIGN, GENEROUSLY FINANCED, WOULD REMOVE THE PROTECTION OF STATE LAW OVER A MAJOR PORTION OF THE MILK INDUSTRY. With the exception of a promise of minimum prices to farmers—but with no guarantee that their milk would reach Grade A market, or that undercounter cuts would not be imposed on them in event of a price war—the whole framework of milk regulation would be destroyed.

More than 1700 of the state's 2196 dairy farmers have organized to fight the bill, and are contributing to the defense fund from their milk checks. They have no confidence in the promise that they would be protected even if the distributors or retailers got into ruinous competition. Some are fearful that chain stores, with affiliated production units, would move into their local markets and leave them high and dry.

THE ELIMINATION OF THE QUOTA AND POOL SYSTEM WOULD REMOVE INCENTIVE FOR A DAIRYMAN TO MAINTAIN A SUPPLY OF GRADE A MILK on the Portland or another market. It would leave a community at the mercy of fluctuations in the supply due to underselling or other conditions. It could help a big retailer to freeze out a smaller competitor by using milk as a "trade leader" to attract more customers than he would normally get.

Portland's milk supply would be endangered further by failure of the bill to establish minimum prices to producers in the state of Washington now shipping to the Portland metropolitan market. Without a guaranteed price, these could be beaten down, and might find other Grade A markets, or go into factory sales.

THE TRUTH IS THAT MILK IS THE BEST FOOD BUY IN OREGON. PRICES ARE COMPARABLE TO THOSE IN OTHER CITIES AND HAVE BEEN MORE CONSTANT. THE PUBLIC HAS A STABLE SUPPLY OF A VITAL PRODUCT. And the dairy industry is getting a fair return for its investment. THIS NEWS SHOULD THINK THE VOTERS WILL BE INVITING TROUBLE IF THEY REPEAL MILK CONTROL.
