Leo Durocher May Try Movie Career

HOLLYWOOD (AP)—Leo Durocher is thinking of following his wife, Laine Day, into the motion picture field.
 The manager of the New York Giants says he has some proposals from the movie industry and that after the 1952 season he may give up baseball and become a movie producer.

"I'm giving the matter very serious consideration," Durocher told a newsmen yesterday. He said he would like to be able to spend more time with his family in California.
 Durocher and the attractive Laine, whom he married in 1947, maintain a home on 4 1/2 acres near the Riviera Country Club in Santa Monica. She has two children by a previous marriage.

"Of course, it may be that I'll find I'm not capable of handling this proposed venture into the movies. But I might I might give it a try, anyhow."
 Right now, Durocher is rehearsing for a role in a movie, "Main Street to Broadway," with Tallulah Bankhead. Miss Day is active both in movies and television.

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Red-haired actress Dorothy Comingsore declined to say whether she is a member of the Communist party as she opened her custody fight for her two children.
 She seeks custody of Judith, 11, and Michael, 8. Resisting her is her former husband, screen writer Richard J. Collins, 38, who renounced communism two years ago and testified in Washington as a co-operative witness.
 Collins' counsel, Mrs. Mable Wilbrandt, asked Miss Comingsore in court yesterday.
 "Are you a member of the Communist party?"
 Miss Comingsore testified she is a loyal American and declared, "My people helped settle this country — they helped to found New Amsterdam and to settle Kentucky."
 The actress denied being intoxicated in front of the children, as charged, and stated that her ex-husband is almost \$15,000 behind in the \$500-a-month support payments ordered by the court. They were divorced in 1946.

Parliament Mulls Coronation TV

LONDON (AP)—Some Labor members of Parliament today demanded a parliamentary debate on an official decision to ban live television broadcasts of Queen Elizabeth's coronation in Westminster Abbey next June.
 Widespread criticism of the decision followed the announcement by the Coronation Commission that live TV shots would be restricted to the royal procession before and after the crowning. The reason for the ban was fear that television might show the Queen too candidly—pating her hair-do or mopping her brow.
 Newsreel and film shots of the ceremony will be permitted but the films will be censored.

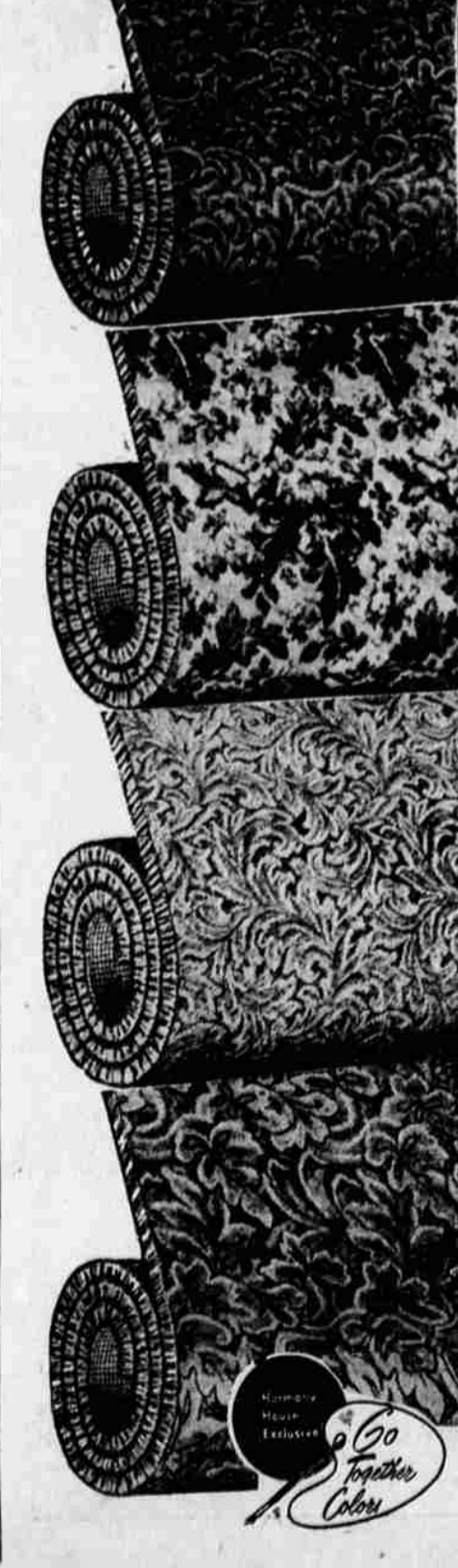
