

U.N. Secretary-General Creates Group To Study U.N.-U.S. Congress Relations

UNITED NATIONS, N. Y. (AP)—Trygve Lie began recruiting an international jurists' panel today to study what U. N. employees have to tell to U. S. congressional investigators.

Lie already had fired one American U. N. employee who balked at a McCarran committee question, suspended another and put 10 on special leave.

The new group, the U. N. Secretary-general said, would study the application of U. S. laws to U. N. employees, especially those who are American citizens, and the rights of investigating bodies to ask them questions about their private lives.

Lie announced last night he had dismissed Stanley Graze, 38,000-a-year railway statistics expert of the U. N. Technical Assistance Administration, and suspended Joel Gordon, pending a full investigation, from his \$10,000 post of trade analysis expert of the Economic Affairs Department.

Lie's statement said both had refused to tell the Senate internal security subcommittee, at hearings in New York Oct. 13-15, whether they are "presently engaged in espionage activities against the United States."

Those put on special leave, a new U. N. category under which they will draw full pay while their cases are investigated, had refused to answer committee questions about Communist affiliations.

A spokesman said the case of Ruth Crawford, publications officer of the Children's Fund, still is under review. She admitted that she had been a Communist party member—briefly in 1935.
