

Oretech Will Pull All Stops Against Ashland Red Raiders

Owlies, SOC Mix Saturday

Captain Rex Hunsaker yesterday sparked rumors that the Oregon Tech Owls would pull all punches against Southern Oregon Saturday night to have the big wallop for Boise JC a week later.

"We'll use all our horses," Hunsaker said. "Although there'll be a few line-up changes that we feel will by no means weaken our team."

Some of the changes include: Dean Weekly in a linebacker spot. Weekly is back after a broken ankle sidelined the OTT veteran for the first half of the campaign.

Laverne Cimil at a defensive end position. Regular Don McIntosh will probably be kept out of the contest with an injured knee. Cimil has been looking good in workouts this week.

Laverne Stewart will probably see plenty of action at a defensive guard position. Paul Patrick is nursing a knee injury and may see just limited action.

Greene Rudd will replace Leroy Widing at the offensive tackle position, saving the latter for defensive work.

Rudd will be the only offensive change. Charlie Wagner will be at the other tackle spot. Dick Flannigan and Cecil Spencer hold down the wings, with Bill McLain and Floyd Pringle at guards and Ralph Vick at center.

Gino Lelli will open at quarterback. Don Foreman and Len Gettlin at the halfback posts and Larry Jeter at fullback.

DEFENSE. Defensively, Cimil and Jerry Wyatt will work the ends. Widing and Jim Duerfles the tackles. Dennis Johnson and Stewart the guards. Chimp Prayso joins Weekly as linebacker. Harry Thompson will be at one halfback position with either Odie Canada or Ralph Perkins at the other halfback spot. Bill Buckingham is at safety.

Vick may be called on for full time at center. Jerry Schubert has missed practice this week with a cold and probably won't be ready for more than just limited duty.

It's a homecoming clash for the Owls. Pretty Margie Davis and her court of five lovelies will rule over the contest and all pre-game and post-game activities.

A victory for the Owls would not only bulge their record to 5-1 but would also mark the first time Oretech has beaten its cross-mountain grid rival.

Although soundly by Linfield, Humboldt State and Chico State, the Red Raiders hold victories over Eastern Oregon and Oregon College. Oretech's two remaining Oregon Collegiate Conference rivals.

Kickoff time is 8 o'clock. Lynn Apluship, San Jose State Quarterback, once threw six touchdown passes in one game while in Wilson (Los Angeles) High School.

It's homecoming for the Illini, so despite the national telecasting of the contest in cavernous Memorial Stadium, a sell-out crowd of 71,000 will be on hand.

The wizards of odds apparently went to print before the Illinois hospital list was published, so the Illini rate a one-touchdown favorite over a Purdue team which has lost only to Notre Dame in four starts.

Injuries especially have weakened Illinois in pass defense, a department that probably will be busy as Purdue's Dale Samuels tries to outpitch Illini Tommy O'Connell.

Pirates, Axemen Mix In Top Prep Quarrel

Five big games dominate high school football in Oregon this week end, and the biggest of all will be at Eugene.

The state's No. 1 team, Marshfield, unbeaten in six consecutive games, will tangle with Eugene, the state's No. 8 team in the latest Associated Press poll.

The game probably will determine which team enters the state playoffs as the district 5 representative in class 1.

Eugene has won five games and dropped one, a 20-6 loss to Klamath Falls. Eugene, however, gained a 41-7 victory over Springfield, a team that Marshfield could down only by a 20-14 score.

EDGE

Marshfield had the edge, though, over two other common opponents. Marshfield downed Cottage Grove, 40-7, and Roseburg, 42-8. Eugene won from Cottage Grove, 18-6, and from Roseburg, 27-0.

Central Oregon also will see a clash featuring two teams from the top 10 in the state. Prineville, No. 7 in the latest poll, will go against Bend, a team that is in a tie for tenth place.

The game does not count in district standings, for Prineville is a class 2 team.

Rumor Cards May Move

HOUSTON, Tex. (AP) — A report that a group of wealthy Houston people had made an offer to transfer the St. Louis Cardinals to Houston drew "top comment now" from Fred Saigh, president of the National League club.

But Saigh said "I may have something to say about it later." Saigh has been in Houston studying the situation of the Cardinals farm club in the Texas League. Recently Allen Russell resigned as president of the Houston club to become owner of the Beaumont franchise.

The report, which had no official source, was that the deal involved moving the Cardinals to Houston but not sale of the National League franchise.
