MILK PRODUCTION AND MARKETING ACT BILL—Purpose: Authorizes governor to appoint milk control administrator, an instrumentality of state, with annual salary of \$7200, vested with power to investigate, supervise and regulate the production of milk for human consumption within the state. Act requires butterfat labeling of milk and licensing of milk dealers. Appropriates license fees for expense of administration. Authorizes administrator to designate marketing areas, require uniform records and accounts to be kept by producers and dealers, fix minimum milk production prices after public hearing, and require bonds of milk dealers. Appeals are provided for and penalties for violations; all existing milk control laws are repealed.

CAB Drafts New Safety Rules

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Civil Aeronautics Board has drafted tentative new safety regulations for the nation's airlines.

Reversible propellers themselves have been defended by the Civil Aeronautics Administration, which has declared that the braking effect of reverse-pitch propellers is so effective that four accidents costing 93 lives in the last five years might have been prevented had the planes' propeller been reversible.

Plane Blasts Red Convoy

U. S. FIFTH AIR FORCE Korea (AP)—A B-26 invader bomber shot up 13 Communist trucks Wednesday and the pilot said the Red convoy leader had only himself to blame.

Other proposed regulations would require that:
1. Life belts, rafts, flashlights and other "ditching" equipment be carried, in properly distributed positions, on airplanes operating over water, and passengers be briefed in advance on their use.
2. Airplane load limits be adjusted according to temperature and humidity. Pilots have found that an airplane's ability to take off decreases under conditions of high temperatures and high humidity.
