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Nixon Charges Democrats With Attacks On Character

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Sen. Richard M. Nixon swung into a day of campaigning in his home county Friday after calling upon Gov. Adlai Stevenson to say whether he would retain Dean Acheson as secretary of state if elected president. The Republican vice presidential candidate also charged that his wife and family had been included in a campaign "of character assassination in the worst low-blow Truman tradition." Nixon said in a statement that he was recently told that President Truman informed a group on his last visit to California "that an all-out personal attack would be launched against me during the last week of the campaign." "The strategy was to have a new false charge issued each day so that the truth could never catch up with the falsehood," he added. "It is obvious that this scheme is under way." He accused the Democratic National Committee of issuing "a lying attack against my mother, father and brother" last Tuesday. Then, he said, the Democratic national chairman issued another statement the same day raising questions about the senator's income. And on Wednesday the State Department issued a statement "which sought to give a sinister connotation to a routine senatorial office letter," he had written. "Today," Nixon added, "a syndicated gossip, who peddles the line of the Democratic National Committee, charged my wife with perjury." Nixon added. No Subpoena Says Taxman

SEATTLE (AP)—Internal Revenue Commissioner John Dunlap denied here early today that he ever had been subpoenaed by a House judiciary subcommittee in Washington which is investigating tax irregularities. Dunlap, here to attend installation of new tax officials today, said "I never have received a subpoena on any subject. It is a complete misstatement. We have given them 100 per cent co-operation and we will continue to do so. I won't make any other comment."

Dunlap was answering charges of Chairman King (D-Calif.) and Rep. Keane of New Jersey, ranking Republican member of the subcommittee, that he had refused to appear at a subcommittee meeting when the subpoena deadline expired Wednesday afternoon. The committee has ordered a probe of possible political pressure in the government's settlement of a five million dollar tax case against the late movie magnate William Fox for \$295,000. "Mr. Fox died in 1941 and I have been in office 15 months," Dunlap commented, "and we fired revenue agent Adrian H. Ash after we learned Fox's motion picture firm had flown Ash's wife to California."
