

### Aides Urge Adlai to Run Again In '56

SPRINGFIELD, Ill. (AP) — Gov. Adlai E. Stevenson's presidential headquarters were being demobilized Thursday but his top lieutenants already were talking of another Adlai-Stevenson movement for 1956.

Out of the wreckage of the Democratic defeat has grown a strong feeling here that Stevenson as titular head of the Democratic party will be the top challenger against the Republicans in another four years.

The Illinois governor remained silent on his future plans so far as the party leadership was concerned. But those around him did not consider his defeat Tuesday by Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower as the finish of his political career.

Stevenson was expected to make clear within the next few weeks, after a vacation, what his personal plans will be.

Those around Stevenson saw the governor as the leader of the party in the months ahead and expected an effort to be made to reorganize and re-build the organization from the bottom up.

Wilson Wyatt, Stevenson's presidential campaign manager, told reporters Wednesday that he and others in the governor's headquarters had discussed the future with Stevenson and he added:

**ADLAI IN '56**

"Our feeling is definitely that it will be Adlai Stevenson in 1956." Wyatt wryly conceded that he and others in the Stevenson command had underestimated the political appeal of Eisenhower. Wyatt had predicted a Stevenson victory by at least 400 electoral votes.

The latest count showed Eisenhower with 442 electoral votes and Stevenson with only 85.

The Stevenson command still was trying to put together an analysis of just what had happened in Tuesday's election—and what were the reasons for the Stevenson defeat.

Wyatt told a news conference that the Republican theme of "time for a change" had snowballed into such proportions that no one could have stopped the trend.

### McCarthy Lags In Wisconsin

MILWAUKEE, Wis. (AP) — Sen. Joseph R. McCarthy, one of the stormiest issues on the national political scene, won his second term handily Tuesday but he trailed President-elect Eisenhower and the entire state ticket in Wisconsin.

The Republican senator's Communist-in-government charges were endorsed by 84,304 voters in returns from 3,137 of Wisconsin's 3,225 precincts.

His Democratic opponent, Thomas E. Fairchild, former state attorney-general and U. S. attorney, drew 702,892 votes.

McCarthy carried 64 of the state's 71 counties in piling up his 141,312 majority.

Eisenhower's margin in Wisconsin Tuesday was more than double McCarthy's. Returns from 2,182 precincts gave him 958,173 votes to 409,637 for Gov. Adlai Stevenson.

The majorities rung up by Wisconsin's Republican state officers, all reflected, were greater than Eisenhower's. Gov. Walter Kohler Jr. and Secretary of State Fred Zimmerman set new records.

McCarthy said in a statement following his victory, "I am deeply grateful to the people of Wisconsin for their vote of confidence."

But from his opponents there none of the customary post-election expressions of good wishes. James Doyle, chairman of the state Democratic organizing committee, declared:

"To McCarthy, war unto the death."
