

Merrill, Jacksonville Meet Tonight

Playoff Position At Stake

There's more than the Dist. 5 Class-B football title at stake tonight in Merrill when the Huskies host the Jacksonville Redskins in a showdown clash billed for 7:30.

The same title package is a berth in the state playoffs and a chance to go all the way to the top of the state's Class B football heap.

Ray Hader, in his second year at the helm of the Huskies, guided Merrill to the Klamath County grid throne. He did it with a couple of backs who like to romp, Jerry Wolfram and Johnny O'Neil, and a rock-ribbed forward wall anchored by five seniors in the middle tackle: Bill Hill and Ray Mattson, guards Jack Hendrickson and Dan Barry and center Bernie Anderson.

FIRST TRY
This is Jacksonville's first fling in 11-man football. Last year the Redskins were runners-up in the state six-man playoffs.

Steering the ground attack are brothers Don and Leroy Clay, who operate from the halfback posts in Jacksonville's wing-T formation.

The quarterbacks is Don Green, 173 pounds, who majors in punting in the wing-T system. Fullback is 185-pound Harvey Huggers, in the starting offensive line are Knute Joe Nolan and Dick Souza, tackles Dick Teal and Leonard Wicksten, guards Marvin Maxwell and Dace Maddox and center Tom Weil.

But the Redskins whipped another A-2 school, Eagle Point, 29-12. They clinched the Jackson County Class B crown with a convincing 33-6 victory over Talent.

Pirates, North Bend Mix for Dist. 5 Title

University High of Eugene bashed into the state football playoffs Thursday night, and seven more high schools intend to follow suit this week end.

University High won the district 5 title in class 2 play by downing Sacred Heart of Salem in a playoff, 14-6, at Salem. That leaves five more titles to be decided in class 2 this week end.

TOP GAME
Two other district championships will be decided in class 1 before the state playoffs start next week end.

The top game comes at North Bend, where the state's No. 1 team, Marshfield, tangles in a traditional battle with neighboring North Bend. The North Bend team was ranked No. 6 in the latest Associated Press poll.

Favored Marshfield goes into the game undefeated and undefeated North Bend has lost one game. The winner is expected to be the district 5 representative in the playoffs.

The only other class 1 berth still undecided is in district 8, where Albany meets traditional rival Corvallis. A win for favored Albany would give that team a tie with Bend. A district vote would be necessary to determine the team to enter the playoffs. A Corvallis win would hand the title to Bend.

CLASS 2
The class 2 title action will go like this:
St. Helens at Columbia Prep in Portland for the district 1 crown Saturday.
Willamina at Sheridan for the district 3 title Friday.
Ashland vs. Coquille for the district 6 championship Friday.
Vale, ranked No. 10 in the state, at Ontario, for the district 7 title. Prineville, ranked No. 9 in the state, at Redmond for the district 8 crown.

There also will be several non-title games attracting attention. Among these will be The Dalles, ranked No. 5 in the state, vs. Hood River, and Benson of Portland, No. 8 in the state, vs. Beaverton.

The Big Six title will be decided as Eugene plays at Salem. There also will be Roseburg at Grants Pass and Pendleton at Milton-Freewater.
