### Oregon Congressmen Get New Patronage Benefits

WASHINGTON (AP)—Oregon's congressional delegation will have new patronage benefits when the House of Representatives and Senate convene early next year. For the first time in 20 years they will be asked to name postmasters in their home districts. Although the two senators and four representatives will not hold committee chairmanships, their influence as committee members will be increased because they are members of the majority party. Sen. Corcoran retains the No. 3 spot on the Appropriations Committee and the Interior and Insular Affairs Committee. Both are considered of vital interest to the West. The status of Sen. Morse, who held the party's top job, would have been in line to become the second-ranking member of the Armed Services Committee and hold the No. 4 position on the Labor and Public Welfare Committee. ### Killer Suspect Said Suicide

LONDON, Colo. (AP)—A 28-year-old farmer, sought for the slaying of a sheriff and his deputy, ended his life with a blast from a high-powered rifle yesterday as authorities cornered him on a heavily traveled

highway west of here. Caught in the glare of state patrol spotlights, Clarence Hass placed the muzzle of a 30-30 caliber rifle in his mouth and pulled the trigger.

His death ended an all-night search which began when the bullet-punctured bodies of Washington County Sheriff Wesley A. McDonald, 43, and his deputy, Jim Jackson, 36, were found beside their car in the backyard of the Hass farm home, eight miles northwest of London. McDonald and Jackson went to the Hass farm late Saturday. Coroner Park Keller of Akron said Oscar Hass, father of Clarence, had notified McDonald that his son was mentally unbalanced and asked officers to take him into custody.
