Serve Lamb Tasty Ways

Looking for good meat dishes at budget prices? Then buy fore-quarter cuts of lamb. There is a large supply now and they are down in price. Here are three tasty ways to prepare the lamb.

BRAINED LAMB SHANKS

(Yield: 4 servings)
(Cooking time: about 2 hours)
Four lamb shanks (1 1/2 pounds each), 2 tablespoons fat, salt and pepper, 2 cups water, 1 cup diced carrots, 1 cup diced potatoes, 1/2 cup diced celery, 1 medium onion, chopped.

Heat fat in a heavy skillet. Season the shanks with salt and pepper and brown them well in the hot fat. Add the water. Cover and cook slowly or bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 1 1/2 hours. Add more water if necessary to prevent burning. Add carrots, potatoes, celery, and onion. Cook 20 minutes or until vegetables are tender.

LAMB BREAST SAUSAGE STUFFING

(Yield: 6 servings)
(Cooking time: 1 1/2 hours)
Three pounds boned breast of lamb, 1/2 pound pork sausage-meat, salt and pepper, 1 onion, diced, 2 tablespoons fat, 1 cup water, 1/4 cup catsup.

Spread the breast of lamb with the sausage meat. Roll it up and tie with string or secure with metal skewers. Sprinkle with salt and pepper. Heat fat in a heavy skillet and brown the lamb roll in the hot fat.

When well browned, add the water, catsup, and onion. Cover and simmer slowly about 1 1/2 hours or until fork tender. Add small amounts of water during cooking if necessary to prevent burning.

LAMB PINWHEELS

Roll up the stuffed lamb breast as above. Then slice the roll into 1-inch slices (between skewers). Place the slices in a baking dish cut side down and bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 30 to 40 minutes. Pour 1 cup tomato juice over the slices and continue baking until lamb is tender, about 45 minutes more.

PLANTING TULIPS

For best results when planting imported Holland bulbs, follow directions that come with the bulbs. Most tulips are planted at least six inches below the surface of the garden. It is best if the soil can be removed down to that point, and then the bulbs placed carefully in their rows. If your garden is still blooming, however, the bulbs may be inserted between the perennials or annuals by removing the area necessary down to 6 inches for each bulb.

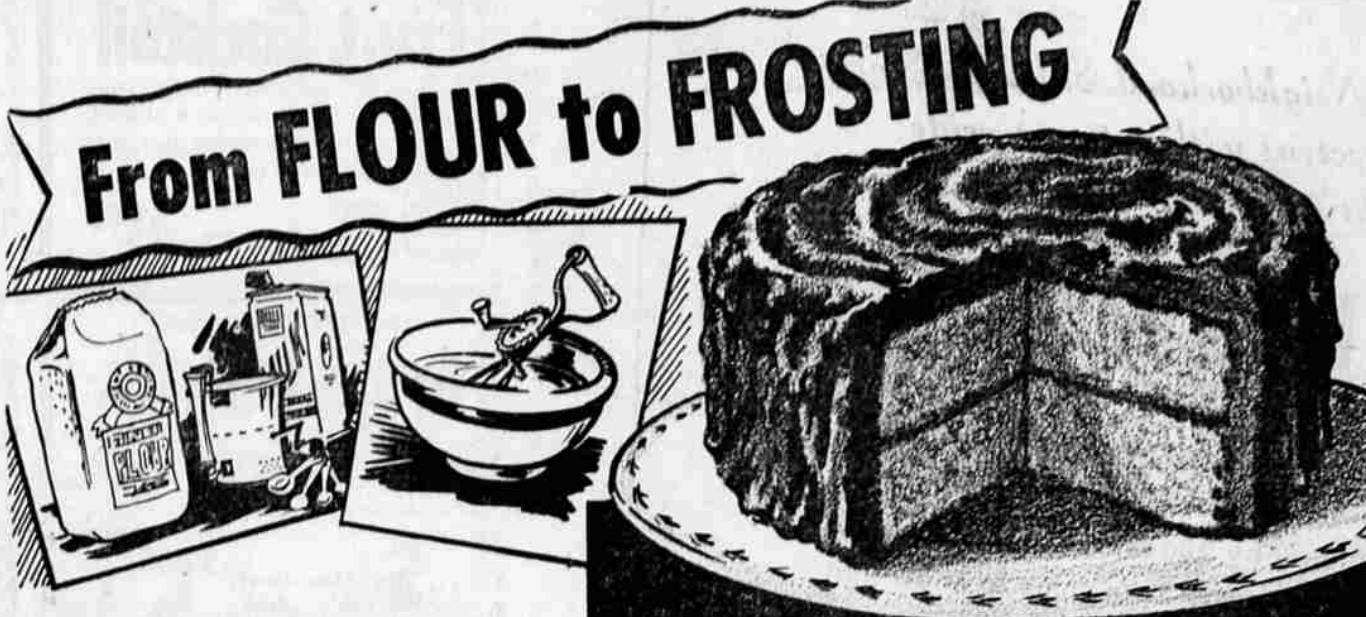
