Official Election Canvass Shows 83 Percent of Voters Cast Ballot

The official canvass of votes cast in Klamath County during the Nov. 4 general election shows 18,225 ballots marked, or a record turnout of some 82.9 per cent of the county's 21,993 registrants. The tally confirmed results previously announced. In the only real close race, Oliver Spiker was elected to the City Council from Ward 1 by a 22-vote margin over Dr. Harry Fredricks, and Arthur (Major) Dickson was elected to the office of county assessor, by 139 votes over Tom Hess.

Attendant Wants Divorce

LONDON (U.S.)—A substitute attendant at Queen Elizabeth's court is seeking a divorce from the wife he married 11 years ago—something that would have cost him his post in Victoria's day.

Formerly strict royal tradition barred from court both innocent and guilty parties in a divorce action. Recently the taboos have slacked a bit.

The suit was filed by RAF group Capt. Peter Townsend, credited with the first German plane shot down over Britain in 1940. Townsend, 37, is an extra equestrian waiting to the Queen. In this unpaid job he acts as an attendant on the young monarch at official functions when the regular equestrians are unable to be present.

Townsend charged his wife, Rosemary, committed adultery. The suit was not defended.

Babies Safer Than Adults

LOS ANGELES (U.S.)—A six-pound baby has a better chance on the operation table than his 40-year-old father.

"That comes from one of the nation's leading baby surgeons, Dr. Orvar Swenson of Boston.

"A baby is a brand new mechanism," Dr. Swenson said yesterday, "pool-pooling the idea that infant surgery is dangerous. 'The parts are all in fine working order. The heart is strong. The tolerance to anesthetic is excellent. And babies heal remarkably well."

"Wouldn't you rather work on a brand new car than try and repair an old worn-out jalopy?" he asked pediatricians and reporters at a meeting at Los Angeles Children's Hospital.
