Highway Work Delays Travel

SALEM (AP)—These construction delays were reported Monday by the Oregon Highway Commission in its weekly road summary:

Corvallis-Newport Highway — 5.2 miles of construction and 1½ mile detour on Newport-Toledo section.

Ochoco — Grading for 10 miles west of Mitchell, rough.

Columbia River — Construction Cascade Locks to Hood River.

The Dalles-California — Construction for 6 miles, Modoc Point to Barclay Springs.

Pacific — Grading 35 miles from Lane County line to Anlauf; grading and surfacing 2.3 miles Chenoweth Park to Oakland Junction.

Coast — Grading 7.25 miles from Reedsport south.

Enterprise-Lewiston — Grading and surfacing Enterprise-Flora section, rough.

Siuslaw — Construction at low pass, occasional one-way traffic.

Umpqua — Grading 2.15 miles on Reedsport-Dean Creek section, rough.

Heppner — Construction for 11 miles on Lena-Nye section, rough.

Crater Lake — North and east entrances closed for winter.

Elkton-Sutherlin — Regrading and surfacing Calapooya Creek-Sutherlin section.

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Washington D.C. Extends Huge Welcome for Ike

WASHINGTON (AP)—The nation's capital whipped up a gigantic welcome today for the next president of the United States.

And the television cameras of all four major networks were set to bring the festivities to the rest of the country beginning at 1 p. m., Eastern Standard Time.

Elaborate plans that won the blessing of the outgoing Truman administration called for a public turnout rivaling the great demonstration which greeted Dwight D. Eisenhower on his return from World War II triumph in 1945.

President Truman, although he campaigned tooth and nail to keep Eisenhower out of the White House, lent a helping hand to today's triumphal procession. He directed that all of the 250,000 federal workers who can be spared from their duties be released from their jobs long enough to join in the cheering.

More than that, painters hastily slapped a layer of gleaming white paint on the outside of the main entrance to the White House executive offices in which today's Truman-Eisenhower talks were to take place.

Brilliant red, white and blue bunting blossomed forth along the route of the Eisenhower motorcade from the Military Air Transport Service Terminal, in nearby Virginia, across Memorial Bridge spanning the Potomac, to the President-elect's future home at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue.

Mrs. Eisenhower is flying in with her husband, but she won't go along to the White House. Instead, she'll visit her sister, Mrs. George Moore, Jr., who lives in the northwestern part of the city.

Why didn't the future first lady go along for a look at her new home?

Well, she wasn't invited until the last minute—until yesterday, in fact. The President's staff added a quick explanation that Mrs. Truman didn't know until Sunday that her successor was coming to Washington with the general.

Invited by telephone yesterday, Mrs. Eisenhower said sorry but she'd made other plans for the afternoon. The White House said, however, that she promised to come down from New York real soon and have a talk with Mrs. Truman about White-Housekeeping.

Because of the welcoming plans, the arrival time of the Eisenhowers after their flight from Augusta, Ga., was set back to 1:25 p. m., EST. This allowed for a 50-minute procession to the White House, where the briefing of the incoming president was scheduled to begin at 2 p. m.

Army, Navy Air Force and 10 or 12 other bands were posted along the route of the motorcade. Armed forces security guards were ordered at the White House and at the airport, where District of Columbia leaders planned a brief greeting ceremony.

Many business houses followed

the government's lead and gave their employees time off to join the throngs lining the capital's streets. A forecast of clear, mild weather bolstered expectations of a vast turnout.

After the White House talks, the

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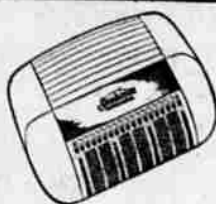
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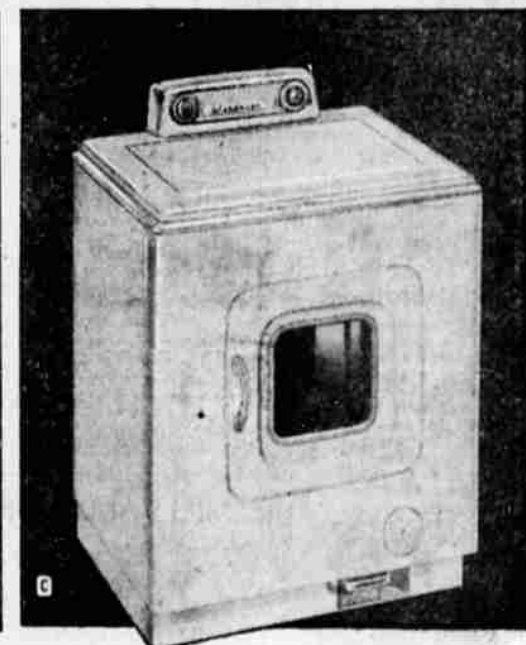
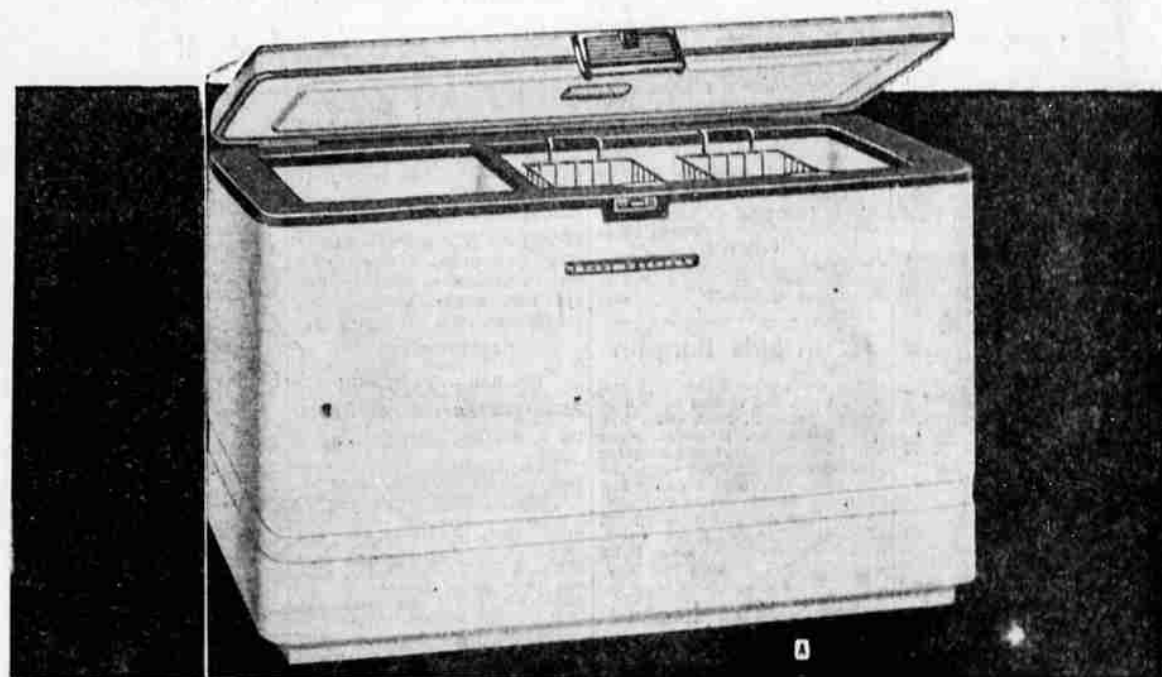
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
