### White-Indian Marriage OK'd

RIO DE JANEIRO, Brazil (AP)—A special ruling by Minister of Agriculture Joao Guephias will make possible the marriage of a white government worker and an Indian princess he courted deep in the Mato Grosso jungle.

Normally the government bans such matches with Indians, who are wards of the state.

The prospective groom, Ayres Camara Cunha, met Princess Diacina—Prairie Flower—four years ago while on a government expedition into the remote Indian country. The plump 18-year-old girl, father was a chief of the Kalapalos, a primitive tribe in which the women wear only loin cloths.

Having become a Roman Catholic, she wants a Christian marriage ceremony and has been awaiting government permission in a hut on the outskirts of Rio de Janeiro. She flew there last week with her father and two brothers.

Camara, a government worker among the Indians, will return to the jungle with his bride.

### William Green Funeral Held

COSHOCTON, O. (AP)—William Green, a powerful labor leader to eight million American workers but a "plain man" to his home folk, was laid to rest yesterday.

The 62-year-old American Federation of Labor president, who rose from Eastern Ohio's coal pits to become one of the labor world's most powerful figures, died Friday of a heart attack.

The Rev. John H. Shanley, pastor of the First Baptist Church, where Green was a member, called Green "a plain man, grown from humble and plain surroundings to great heights, but he never forgot his fellow man."

The services were held in Grace Methodist Church because Green's church could not accommodate the persons who came to pay a last tribute to him. Seventeen hundred persons crowded inside the church, 5,000 more were on the outside and a throng lined the streets leading to the cemetery.

Last night, Mrs. Jennie Green, his 82-year-old widow, listened to a tape recording of the funeral services. Bedfast from an illness of several years, Mrs. Green, tiny and white-haired, was unable to attend the last rites.

### Reds Sentence 'Marketeers'

MOSCOW (AP)—The government newspaper Ivestia reported today that 16 big-time blackmarketeers in wool and silk cloths have been convicted and sentenced to prison terms ranging from five to 10 years.

The property of all 16 has been confiscated by the state.

The ring bought yard goods in Moscow stores, transported it to Tbilisi in Georgia and sold it at speculative prices, making large profits.

BOSTON (AP)—Joseph P. Kennedy, former ambassador to Great Britain, says he and his son, Sen. Elect John F. Kennedy (D-Mass.), are "in complete disagreement" on foreign policy.

"I couldn't possibly have a worse argument with anyone about foreign policy than I have had with my son," the elder Kennedy told a high school association meeting Monday night.

The former ambassador said he is an "isolationist because I don't think the kind of help we're giving has produced anything like the results it was supposed to produce."

### Force Seeks Globemaster

ANCHORAGE, Alaska (AP)—The Air Force, Navy and Coast Guard combined forces today for a sweeping search of the island-dotted northern Gulf of Alaska for a lost C124 Globemaster and its 52 passengers and crew.

The huge Globemaster, the third military air transport lost in Alaska since Nov. 7, vanished Saturday on a flight here from McChord Air Base, Wash. It carried a crew of 11 and 41 military passengers.

A report that wreckage had been sighted near Middleton Island, where the Globemaster made its last radio contact Saturday, caused



a brief flurry of excitement yesterday. It was later discovered that the "wreckage" sighted was driftwood and seaweed.
