 Gov. Arthur B. Langlie commented, "The world's first floating

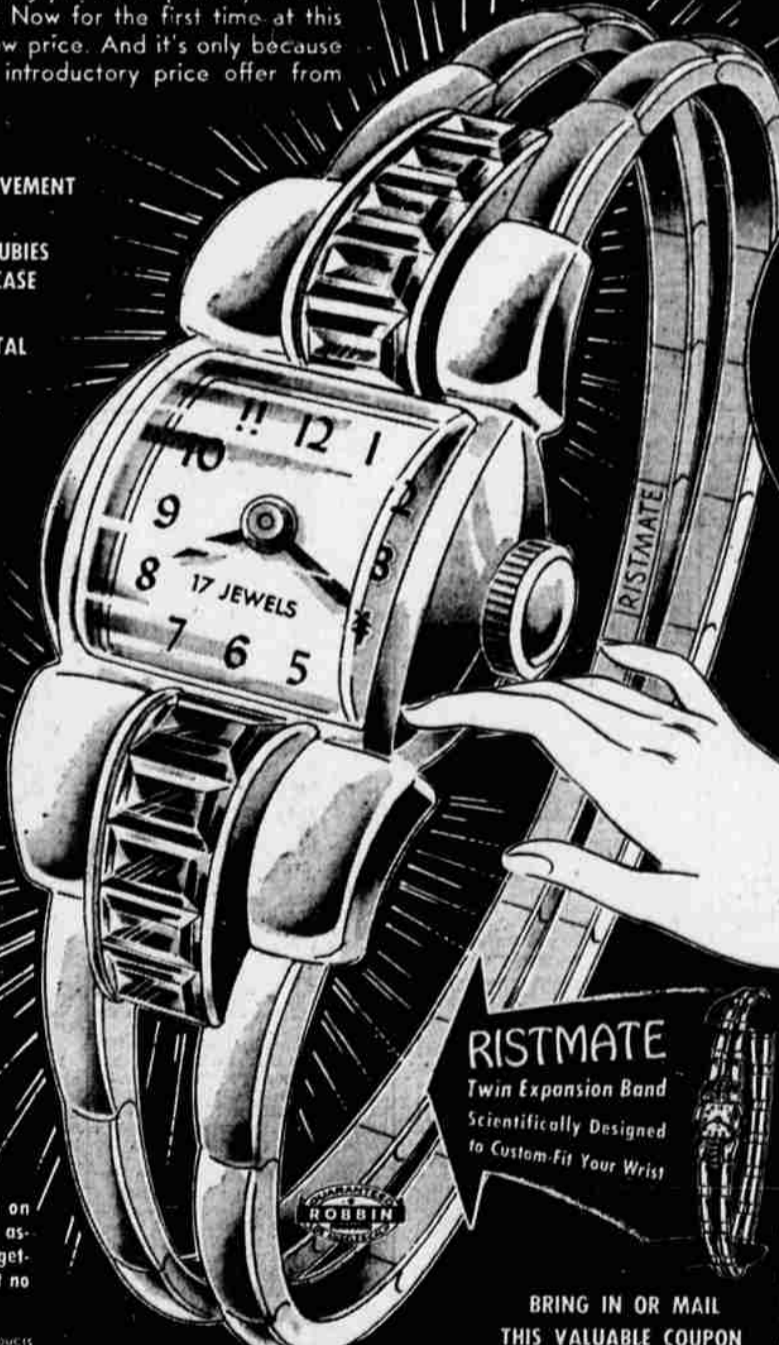

 R. A. J. Chislett, clerk to the Wallington, Surrey, justices, told of the 100 cases, which he termed typical, showed the following percentages of causes:
 Another woman, 42 per cent; incompatibility, 36 per cent; money troubles, 5 per cent; sex troubles, 3 per cent; excessive drinking, 3 per cent; gambling, 2 per cent; nagging wife, 1 per cent; unknown causes, 8 per cent.

Wainwright To Testify

NEW YORK (AP)—Counsel for John D. Provo, says the ex-soldier's commander on Corregidor, Gen. Jonathan M. Wainwright, will appear as a witness for the defense.
 A lawyer for Provo, on trial for treason, said yesterday the retired general "would like to testify during the week of Dec. 8." He resides at San Antonio, Tex.
 Wainwright and Provo, a former sergeant, were captured by the Japanese in the fall of Corregidor in 1942.
 Provo, who could pay with his life if convicted, is accused of going over to the enemy and informing against his fellow Americans.
 The Federal Court trial, recessed today, resumes tomorrow.
