FPC to Study Gas Imports

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Federal Power Commission will resume a hearing Feb. 1 to determine the feasibility of importing Canadian natural gas into the Pacific Northwest.

A commission official who asked that his name not be used pending a formal announcement of the decision told a reporter it was reached at a closed meeting of the commission Tuesday.

It was not known whether the February session would pick up where the case stood when the hearing was recessed last July or start from scratch.

The early summer hearing involved six companies, five of which sought commission permission to bring Canadian gas into the Pacific Northwest and a sixth, Northern Natural Gas Co., which wanted to pipe Canadian gas into the Midwest.

At that time, none of the applicants had received authority from the Canadian government to export gas from that country.

Since the hearing recessed, one company—Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corp., Houston, Texas—has abandoned its Canadian plans, and a second applicant, Westcoast Transmission Co., Inc., has been authorized by Canada to build a 99-mile pipeline from the Northern Alberta-British Columbia border area to Vancouver, B.C., and the U.S.-Canadian border.

In abandoning its Canadian plans, Pacific filed an application with the commission to pipe natural gas to the northwest states from New Mexico.

Other concerns whose applica-

tions are consolidated into the one proceeding include Northwest Natural Gas Company, Glacier Gas Company, and Trans-Northwest Gas, Inc.
