FBI Cracks Larceny Ring
PORTLAND (AP) — The FBI said here Wednesday that an interstate car-stealing operation had been broken up because of a tip from a Salem used car dealer.

James Postler, agent in charge of the Portland FBI office, did not disclose the name of the Salem dealer, but said 22 cars had been recovered.

He said the Salem dealer became suspicious July 17 when a man who gave his name as Charles Smith offered a 1952 car for sale. The dealer said he recognized Smith as a man who sold him another car in 1949 under another name.

Postler said that as a result Wesley Payne, 50, Portland, and Marvin L. Garrett, 37, Vancouver, Wash., are being held for the federal grand jury on car theft charges with bail set at \$10,000 for each.

He added that investigation disclosed three of the cars stolen over a three-year period had been sold to dealers in Salem, who were unaware they had been stolen.

Postler said the men would take cars in one state, drive to another to sell the cars, take more cars in that state, and sell them in still a third state. Eventually the investigation went into eight Western states, he said.
