## Bend May Get Polio Center

BEND (AP) — Plans for expanding polio treatment facilities in Central Oregon, with the possibility of establishing a complete center at St. Charles Memorial Hospital here, is under study.

Appointment of a study committee headed by Dr. R. C. Cutler followed the visit here this week of Dr. S. B. Osgood of Portland, epidemiologist for the State Board of Health, and Gene Masecki, Portland, state representative of the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis.

Dr. Osgood said that with minor alterations, the third floor of the old hospital building could be converted into an isolation ward for polio and other more contagious diseases. The physical therapy department of the hospital is equipped at present to handle most types of polio, and lacks only a Hubbard tank for full body immersion, or a small concrete swimming pool.

The old hospital building is connected to the new structure, which was built with federal and locally subscribed funds and put into use in May, 1951.

## Naguib Slashes Royal Privilege

CAIRO (AP) — Maj. Gen. Mohamed Naguib's tough reform government stripped Egypt's royal family of more privileges yesterday.

The Cabinet ordered dissolution of the Crown Council, which was set up in 1922 to handle all judicial matters concerning the King and other members of the royal house. It was made up of several princes, palace dignitaries and Cabinet members.

Henceforth, royalty will come under the jurisdiction of the ordinary court, like all other Egyptians.

## New Commie Tactic Feared

WASHINGTON (AP) — American officials say Russia may launch a campaign of harassment against Berlin in an attempt to discourage the European Defense Army.

They told a reporter Thursday such a program of threats and restrictions would coincide with Western intelligence reports that the Soviet has nearly doubled the size of the East German "police force."

The officials said this buildup began last June after Chancellor Konrad Adenauer signed the European Army agreement and the peace contract. The East Germans have 24 "alert units" now supplied with small arms. Reports are their numbers as well as the size and amount of armament shipments are being increased.

## Exposure Kills Man

CHILOQUIN — Elwin Smith, about 50, was found dead apparently of exposure at his residence here yesterday morning.

The body was discovered by Elwood Miller, who dropped by the house at about 8:45 a.m. and found Smith lying on the floor near a couch clad only in socks and jeans.

According to investigation by the sheriff's office, Smith was last seen shortly after midnight Wednesday when friends and relatives left him asleep on the couch. They said they put blankets over him.

This morning it appeared he had gone outside and collapsed before reaching the porch when he returned.

The body was taken to Ward's Klamath Funeral Home.
