One will deal with development of the nations' industry and agriculture, the other with world-wide finance and trade. Membership of the two committees will be largely identical.

### Doctors Fix Heart Wound

INDIANAPOLIS (AP)—The Indiana University Medical Center announced Friday it had succeeded in patching a hole the size of a half dollar in a 13-year-old boy's heart.

The boy, Richard Duffy of near Linton, Ind., had been brought to Riley Hospital for children at the medical center several weeks ago because of a "chronic state of heart failure."

Surgeons found the boy had been born with the defect, a hole between the left and right auricle chambers of the heart, putting an additional strain on the heart and causing an enlargement of the organ.

### Parade To Fete McKay

PORTLAND (AP)—Oregon's formal celebration of Gov. Douglas McKay's appointment as secretary of the interior will be a parade here Saturday morning.

When the parade disbands at the Civic Auditorium, the governor will speak briefly from the steps. The governor is a long-time rider of horses in parades and it was planned for a time to have him ride in this. But Friday morning Sheriff Terry Schunk said that plan had been dropped.

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Agriculture Department announced Friday that a ban on imports of Canadian cattle and other livestock products will be lifted March 1.
