Chicago Beats Goat In 62nd Year Santa Claus

CHICAGO (AP) — Santa Claus, far away from the wide open spaces of his Missouri home town, got lost in the milling crowds of thousands in Chicago's Loop Friday.

But it's all right, kids—he was found.

The bewhiskered and ruddy-faced old gentleman, dressed in a red tasseled cap and a red, fur-trimmed suit, was only a couple of blocks from his post.

The Santa who got lost in the big city is Henry Barbre, 48, of Marston, Mo., a community of some 800 population. He is one of the many Santas stationed in the loop by a charity group (Volunteers of America).

He told central police he had left his portable chimney and pot at State and Washington streets to get a cup of coffee. He couldn't find his way back and disclosed his predicament to a woman passerby at Randolph Street and Michigan Avenue.

"I'm Santa Claus, all right," he said, "but I'm lost and my chimney and pot are missing."

The woman called a policeman. Santa explained he had come to Chicago only three days ago and he was confused by the large crowds, busy traffic and tall buildings.

Ex-Italian Queen Dies

MONTEPELLIER, France (AP) — Ex-Queen Elena of Italy died at her villa here Friday. She was 75.

The widow of King Vittorio Emanuele III and the mother of former King Umberto II had been under treatment by a French cancer expert for three years.

The queen had been living in exile since the abdication of Vittorio Emanuele in 1946.

Umberto abdicated in May of that year and for a brief period Umberto II was king.

On June 2 Italy voted in favor of a republic and a formal proclamation ending the rule of the House of Savoy was issued on June 16.

Vittorio Emanuele died in Alexandria, Egypt, where he had gone into exile, Dec. 28, 1947.

Umberto was not at the bedside of his dying mother. He is believed to be in Zurich after leaving Paris Thursday.

She was the sixth of 11 children of King Nicholas and Queen Milena of Montenegro.

Four daughters and a son were born to Elena and Vittorio Emanuele.

They were Umberto and the four princesses Jolanda, Malinda, Giovanna and Maria.

Princess Malinda died in Bucharest concentration camp in Germany during World War II. Giovanna is the ex-queen of Bulgaria.

When Queen Elena first went into exile she went to Alexandria, Egypt, but came here in 1950.

Here she was recognized as a fisherwoman, preparing her own bait and often going out alone in a small boat to do her fishing.

Her sister, the Princess of Balteanu, was at her bedside when she died.

Child's Plea Saves Santa

NEW YORK (AP) — Of all things, "Santa Claus" was in trouble, and saucer-eyed Stanley Schwartz told a Bronx magistrate.

"Please don't hurt Santa Claus."

"Why?" asked Magistrate Hilda Schwartz, who is not related to 8-year-old Stanley.

"Because he is good to children," stammered Stanley.

It happened yesterday.

"Santa," 50-year-old Stanley Meyers, who does the Kris Kringle honors each season at a Bronx department store, came to court from work. He was attired in his Santa Claus suit.

An upstairs neighbor had complained about Meyers, said he talked too loud nights when she was trying to sleep. "Santa" laughed too loud, also, the complainant said.

Stanley Schwartz was in court with his mother, a witness in another case.

But Stanley couldn't stand seeing Santa in trouble. He made his impulsive plea yesterday.

After listening to Stanley, Magistrate Schwartz told Meyers:

"If you give me your assurance that you will moderate your tones, or wherever you come from."

Santa agreed, and beamed at little Stanley.

It took only a slight motion by Meyers, for Stanley to leap on his lap and whisper:

"A horse on wheels and a car with headlights."

Old Radioactive Springs Found

WASHINGTON (AP) — Radioactive uranium may be the source of curative powers ascribed since Biblical days to springs near the Lake of Galilee, says a woman scientist from Israel.

D. Ross Goldstein, an official of Haifa Technion Institute, told a news conference Friday an American researcher recently discovered evidence of uranium in the springs.

These "hot springs of Theriac," near the lake where Christ walked on the waters, were popular with Roman governors of the Holy Land and are mentioned in the Bible.

Dr. Goldstein said "one can speculate that radiant energy, a by-product in the atomic age, played a role in any actual cures among people who bathed at the spot in centuries past."

Britain May Have Uranium

LONDON (AP) — Geologists may have found Britain's first new source of uranium in an abandoned, flooded mine in Southwest England, South Terras mine, near St. Austell, Cornwall. Government officials said it contained uranium ore apparently rich enough to be mined commercially.

Preliminary surveys indicate there may be several million pounds of ore in the area.
