Advertising Hits Record

NEW YORK (AP)—National advertising volume reached a new all-time high in October. Printers' Ink will report in this week's issue. The publication's general index went to 475, compared with 456 for the previous two months and the 1935-39 base of 100. Farm magazines, down 1 per cent, was the only media not registering a gain over 1951. Television showed the largest gains over both the previous month and the previous year. Other major media gains over September ranged from 10 per cent for outdoor to 2 per cent for radio. Newspapers, outdoor and business papers followed TV with 11 per cent gains over 1951.

Police Predict Yuletide Violence

PORTLAND (AP)—The joyful Yuletide season is about here, and to the police force that means an increase in armed violence and theft. It happens every year, police said without attempting to explain why. They pointed to the recent bank robbery, and three holdups so far this week. Burglaries also are increasing, they said.

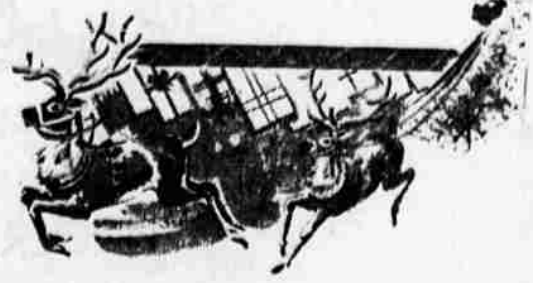
