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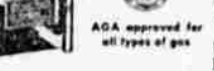

NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE
Oral auction bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor or his authorized representative at the office of the forest supervisor, Post Office Building, Klamath Falls, Oregon, beginning at 2:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time, December 22, 1952, for all the live timber marked or designated for cutting and all merchantable dead timber located in an area embracing about 680 acres within Section 35, T. 35 S., R. 15 E., and Sections 2, 3, 4, and 5, T. 36 S., R. 15 E., W.M. Boulder Creek drainage Fremont National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be about 3,300,000 board feet, more or less of live and marked dead ponderosa pine and sugar pine, 3,000,000 board feet more or less of live and marked dead white fir and other species, and an unestimated amount of unmarked dead timber of all species. The appraised value of the timber according to long-term normal market and operating conditions is \$10.10 per M board feet for live and marked dead ponderosa pine, \$10.00 per M board feet for live and marked dead white fir, and other species, and \$10.00 per M board feet for unmarked dead timber of all species. No bid will be considered which is less than these rates as a base rate applicable through the entire period of the sale agreement, plus an additional amount of at least \$10.83 per M board feet for live and marked dead ponderosa pine and sugar pine, \$0.40 per M board feet for live and marked dead white fir and other species, and \$0.00 per M board feet for unmarked dead timber of all species. Except unmarked dead timber shall be subject to quarterly calendar adjustment upward or downward by 0.4 of the difference between the base index prices for stumpage as set forth below and the average of the Western Pine Association index prices as calculated by the Forest Service at the end of each quarter. Such adjustment in the additional amounts for stumpage shall be applicable to timber cut and scaled during the calendar quarter for which the adjustment is computed. In no event, however, will the adjusted stumpage rates for each quarter be less than the basic appraised rate as first stated above. The base index prices for this sale are an average of the monthly Western Pine Association lumber price indices from August 1, 1952 to October 30, 1952. In addition to the prices bid for stumpage, a cooperative deposit of \$1.30 per M board feet, to be used by the Forest Service for paying the cost of slash disposal, and a cooperative deposit of \$0.60 per M board feet, to cover the cost of tree planting, seed sowing, and timber stand improvement work on the area cut over for the total cut of live and marked dead saw timber under the terms of the agreement, will be required. As a qualification for oral bidding, all bidders must submit a sealed bid accompanied by the required payment to the forest supervisor, Post Office Building, Klamath Falls, Oregon, prior to 2:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time, December 22, 1952. Sealed bids will be posted at the beginning of the auction for the information of the bidders. \$3,000.00 must accompany each bid to be applied on the purchase price, refunded, or retained in part as liquidated damages according to the conditions of the sale. If oral bid is declared to be high at the closing of the auction, the bidder must immediately confirm the oral bid by submitting it in writing on a Forest Service bid form. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Before bids are submitted, Forest Service bid forms for use in submitting sealed bids and full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale and submission of bids should be obtained from the Forest Supervisor, Klamath Falls, Oregon, or the District Ranger, Bly, Oregon.
