NEW YORK (AP) — Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower, sang Christmas carols Sunday night at the doorway of his Columbia University residence in a traditional candle-light ceremony dedicated to the head of the university.

Twenty-two students of Barnard College, a woman's unit of Columbia, began singing carols outside the President-elect's home.

Eisenhower, costless and hatless, came out to greet the students in the chilly air and join in the singing. His wife threw on a coat and came out to hum along with them.

Florence Sloan, 21-year-old Barnard senior, 1700 Greenwich, Conn., asked Eisenhower if he had a favorite carol.

"What was that one we heard on television tonight?" the general asked his wife. Prompted by the girls, he decided it was "The Night Before Christmas," and it was sung. A policeman assigned to the outside of the residence joined in.

The general, who returned Sunday from a trip to the Korean front, told the students: "You certainly have made this a nice homecoming."

"Now is the time for the fruit cake," he said, apparently referring to the custom of rewarding carolers with cake. Smiling at the girls, he told them "I hope you all have A-pluses."

Judith Leverone, 21, of Boston, asked him if he wanted to hear any other favorite carol. He requested "O Come, All Ye Faithful."
