

Japanese Writer Said in Red Spy Network Winds Lash Shipping

TOKYO (AP)—The U. S. told Japan Monday that Leftist writer Wataru Kajii was involved in a Communist spy ring and appealed to U. S. authorities for shelter from his Communist bosses, a highly reliable source said Wednesday.

The source reported: The American note to the Japan-

ese foreign offices said Kajii was lying when he told Parliament he was held illegally by American counter-intelligence agents for more than a year.

The note also told of American efforts to smash a Communist spy ring operating in Japan since at least 1951.

The secret three-page note was delivered to the foreign office in response to questions about Kajii's allegations. Both American embassy and Japanese officials refused to discuss the note.

A foreign office spokesman told a news conference Tuesday that Japanese police were investigating the spy ring.

A Japanese radio operator has been arrested for broadcasting illegal messages to Vladivostok and North Korea. He said he sent them.

HELICOPTERS AID

KUALA LUMPUR, Malaya (AP)—Ten American 10-seater helicopters being diverted to Malaya from Britain will be used to sharpen the offensive against the Communist guerrillas. An army spokesman says the helicopters, allocated to Britain under the Mutual Defense Assistance Program, will lift tired patrols from the jungle, replacing them with new men.

for the Communists only after showing them to U. S. authorities.

A member of the Soviet mission in Japan was involved in the ring, Japanese newspapers reported.

Kajii was reported to be a close associate of the No. 2 Japanese Communist, Sanzo Nozaka.

The source said the American note made these points: Kajii's story was an attempt to convince his Communist bosses he was held under duress. Actually he was not.

American agents discovered while investigating the spy ring that espionage headquarters communicated with its agents through Japanese intermediaries. U. S. agents laid a trap—and caught Kajii. Kajii admitted being a Communist intelligence officer and said his life was in danger because he had confessed. He pleaded for refuge because of fear of his Communist bosses and because he was ill of tuberculosis and needed treatment.

Kajii was offered shelter and medical care. He was released prior to April 28, when the peace treaty went into effect, and made arrangements with friends for his care.

Ten days ago, Kajii apparently felt himself cured and returned home.

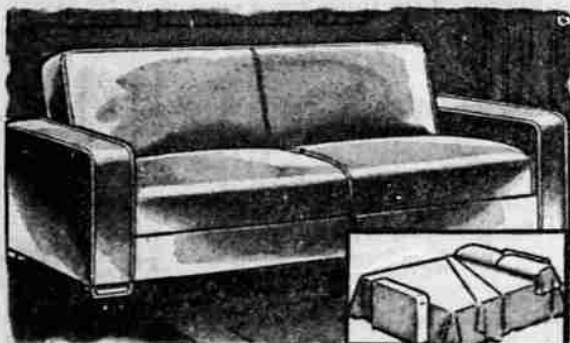

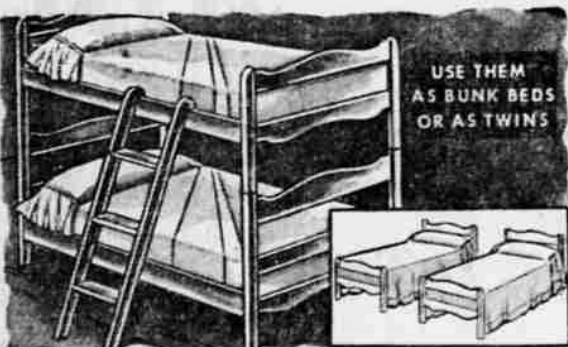

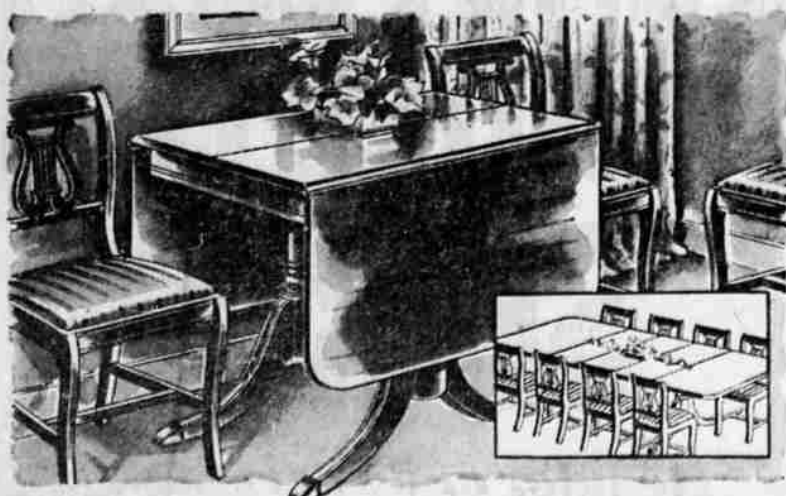

Congressmen Back Aid Cut

WASHINGTON (AP)—A reduction in United States foreign aid funds is favored by 9 out of 10 incoming congressmen willing to take a stand in an Associated Press survey.

Some of this 90 per cent protested hotly what they called waste and poor results in the \$7 billion dollars America has sent its allies during the past 12 years.

Others, among the 10 per cent, defended the program as providing the most defense per dollar.

Thirty-one senators called for foreign aid cuts in their replies. While Sen. Langer (R-ND) said flatly, "Nothing for foreign aid."

Six House members urged no new foreign assistance appropriations and 143 proposed cuts, using words like "severely" and "drastically."

Four senators, some with reservations, opposed reductions, while replies from 23 senators showed no pronounced leanings now. Only 16 representatives—13 Democrats

and three Republicans—indicated support for anything like the present program. Forty-two representatives made noncommittal replies.

Suggestions included:

1. A complete new study of the whole program.

2. Making loans instead of outright grants.

3. Shifting emphasis from Europe to the Middle and Far East.

4. Ending economic aid grants but keeping military assistance and the Point Four program of technical help.
