George Meany, AFL president, said yesterday in a radio interview that the Nov. 4 election results "more or less stopped" the drive for repeal.

**Three Die In State Mishaps**

Three Oregon residents died in accidents last week end.

Two were killed in auto mishaps and one was drowned.

Ernest Charles Fitzgerald, 71, of The Dalles was fatally injured near Washougal, Wash., Sunday when he swerved his car to avoid hitting a dog that was crossing the highway. The car overturned, pinning Fitzgerald underneath. A passenger, Mrs. Millie Bateson, 71, also of The Dalles, was injured.

Bernice Fay Watson, 29, of Milwaukie was killed early Sunday when a car in which she was a passenger crashed into a parked truck south of Portland. Police said Albert Wallert of Estacada was driver of the car.

Ronald Trefren, 9, drowned when he fell into an irrigation pool near his suburban Grants Pass home Saturday. His brother, Larry, 13, dived into the pool and pulled Ronald out, but the boy was dead on arrival at a Grants Pass hospital.

**Windsors Back In U.S.**

NEW YORK (AP)—The Duke and Duchess of Windsor returned to the United States yesterday after several months in Europe.

As they arrived aboard the liner Queen Mary, the duke repeated his statement of last Tuesday that he would not attend the coronation of his niece as Queen Elizabeth II.

The Windsors said they planned to hunt quail near Tallahassee, Fla., and play golf at Palm Beach, Fla., during the next few months.

**Woman Makes Speed Record**

MARSEILLE, France (AP)—Flying a French jet fighter, Mrs. Jacqueline Aurion, daughter-in-law of the French President, broke her own woman's speed record yesterday over a closed 100-kilometer (62.13 mile) course.

Her average time was 534.375 an hour. She had made 511.360 miles an hour in May, 1951.

**GI Praises British Limb**

NEW YORK (AP)—A handless ex-GI leader says the British have a better artificial arm than the United States—and he hopes the Veterans Administration will agree.

Harold Russell, 38, of Natick, Mass., a founder of the Amvets, returned yesterday from a meeting of the World Veterans Federation in London and said the British arm is about 25 per cent better than the one used by the Veterans Administration.

Russell, who lost both hands in World War II, said he would ask Amvets to urge the VA to adopt the British arm.
