Incomplete tallies for the Christmas bird count conducted yesterday in this area by the Nature Society of the Klamath Region show 93 separate species of birds observed...

The rarest record so far showed an Audubon Warbler wintering here when all the rest of her tribe moved to a warm and sunny clime last October.

Startings, becoming more and more numerous in this area, appeared for the first time on the Klamath Christmas Count when one was observed near Algoma.

This is the fifth Christmas count held in this region, conducted by the Nature Society in cooperation with the National Audubon Society's annual Christmas count held throughout the nation.
