Saturday that the Senate proceed to consider new rules. Their purpose is to clear the way for replacing the present Rule XX under which a vote of 60-40 is required, or two-thirds of the entire membership, are needed to choke off a filibuster—the device for talking legislation to death.

In recent years Southern senators have relied on filibusters, or threats of them, to kill federal fair employment practices (FEPC) legislation and other civil rights measures. Opponents of the present rule have proposed that 49 senators, or a majority of the members, be

allowed to call a halt to debate. Sen. Jenner (R-Ind) broke into the argument yesterday to say that a resolution to make it easier to choke off a filibuster would be the first business of the Senate Rules Committee, which he is to head. He said he has prepared a res-

olution that would permit debate to be halted by the votes of two-thirds of the senators present and voting. He will introduce this as soon as possible, Jenner said. Such a change would permit as few as 33 senators to put a limit on debate assuming that only a bare quorum of 49 were present.

In practice, however, the number would be far greater since most senators would be on hand in case of such a test. Taft also told the senate he personally thinks the rules should be liberalized so that filibusters could be halted by the votes of two-thirds of the senators voting.

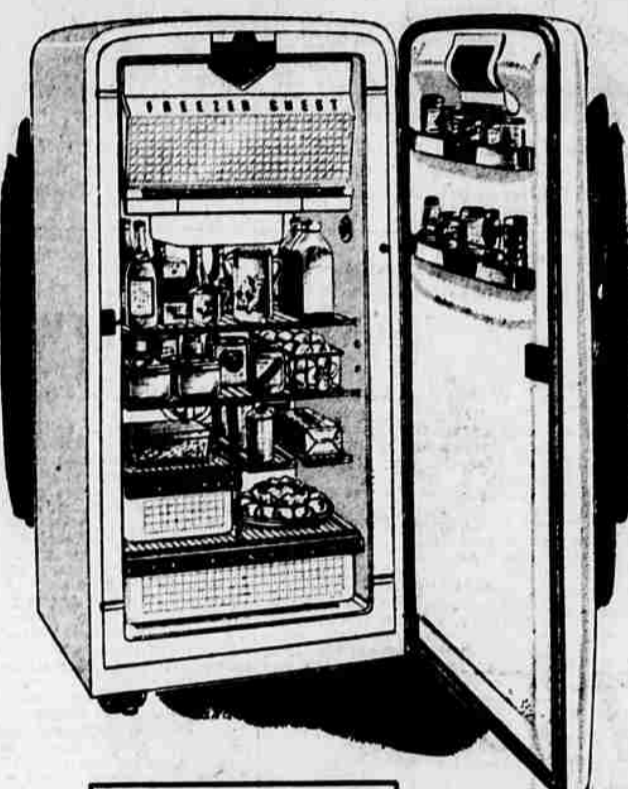

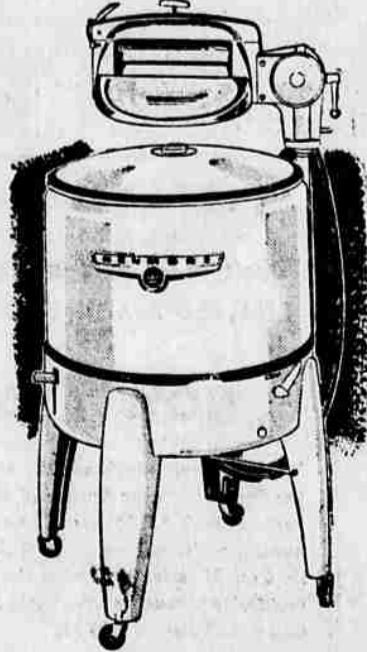
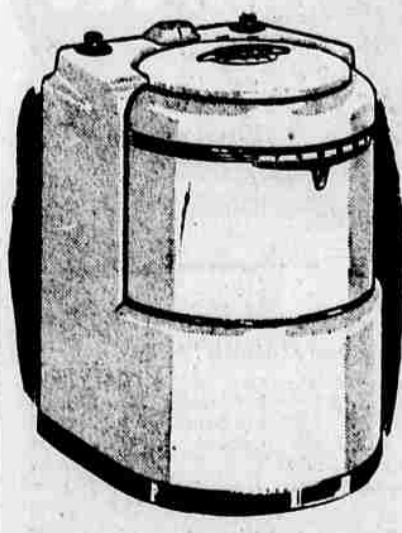
