Sausage and Mushroom Pizza
One-half pound sausage meat, 1-3 cup minced onion, 1 cup tomato sauce (8 ounce can), 3 ounce can chopped broiled mushrooms, 2 tablespoons tomato paste, 2 teaspoons sugar, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1 cup biscuit mix, 1-3 cup milk (approximately), 1 cup grated sharp American cheese.
Cook sausage meat in frying pan

HINTS

NUTMEG TOO
Here's one for the kids. Cook rice in milk in a double boiler. Serve hot and crown with tiny flecks of butter, brown sugar and chopped walnuts. This is good dessert with stick-to-the-rib qualities.

PRUNE FOR SALADS
Calavo avocados are in the markets now and there are lots of them. You can buy them either "firm", or "soft" that are ready to eat. It takes firm fruit from 2 to 4 days to ripen and be sure to keep them at room temperature. Store the soft fruit in the warmest part of the refrigerator until you are ready to use them.

PRUNE PROPS
We like to keep stewed prunes on hand all of the time. Not only do they make a perfect breakfast fruit but they come in so handy for countless types of salads. Pit the fruit and stuff with cottage cheese or any odds and ends of canned or fresh fruit you happen to have on hand. Serve on salad greens with French dressing.
