

MOSCOW (R)—A leading Soviet publication Wednesday blasted Israel's Premier David Ben-Gurion, foreign minister Moshe Sharett, late President Chaim Weizmann as tools of American-British imperialism.

A long editorial in the foreign affairs weekly New Times also charged the Zionists with supporting a policy to establish "bloody, Fascist regimes permeated by a spirit of racial bigotry, including anti-Semitism."

New Times also accused the Israeli nation of waging "a cruel war of destruction against the local Arab population in Palestine." It said that armed Zionist detachments seized land from the Arabs, expelled them into the desert and evicted them from factories.

(These attacks have been viewed in many Western quarters as a Soviet attempt to woo the Arab world, still technically at war with Israel since the 1948 fighting in the Holy Land.)

RANGOON, Burma (AP) — Reinforcements were rushed into South Burma by air and river today to counter an expected thrust by Karen rebels toward the important seaport of Moulmein, Burma's third largest city.

The Burmese Army reported yesterday that it had suffered heavy casualties in fighting with Karen troops at Kawkaireik on the Thailand border 40 miles east of Moulmein. The Army dispatches said the rebels held more than half of Kawkaireik.

The government forces were reported retreating, and observers here said the rebels were planning a thrust at Moulmein.

The battle has been the bloodiest since the Karens revolted in 1948 and demanded a separate state.

Wray Scores

Elpidio said he was digging for buried treasure and would pay for the damage when he found the treasure.

BALTIMORE (AP) — Herbert R. O'Connor, former U. S. senator from Maryland, has been named labor adviser to the city government.

O'Connor, a Democrat who served for a time as chairman of the Senate Crime Committee, will get \$10,000 a year in his new post.

GALS SWIPE SHERIFF'S BADGE
ROCHESTER, Ind., April 11—Chief Deputy Sheriff Deverl Holloway told two girls how to get to South Bend, 40 miles away, but he didn't appreciate how they repaid the good turn.
