A series of demonstrations by physical students under the direction of Gene Marchington, instructor, highlighted the January meeting of the Chilquín PTA Monday evening at the high school auditorium. Colorful Salad Uses Canned Bartlett Pears

Colorful and pretty is this Bartlett Pear salad supreme which will move a meal from the winter doldrums into a gay springlike one. Even though spring is weeks away meals take on a lighter air right after the New Year to get away from the rich food to which we have been accustomed.

Canned Bartlett pears form the base of this salad and are flanked by slices of golden oranges and purple grapes, sugar dipped. The salad is made protein rich with balls of cream cheese rolled in chopped nuts and placed in the core cavity of the canned pears.

The Bartlett Pear is the best known and most popular for canned pears. The firm flesh of the pear makes them particularly well suited for commercial canning. A characteristic which sets them apart is the delicate, fine-grained texture of the flesh, free from grit cells.

Tasty-ready canned Bartlett pears are creamy white in color and have a delicate flavor for many palate-pleasing dishes. The Pacific Coast states are leaders in pear production. The first pear trees were planted by the early pioneers of the country, having been brought here by early settlers from the European homes. The rich volcanic soil of the coastal states coupled with the warm sunshine provided conditions conducive to the growth of pears, so they flourished and grew giving the Pacific Coast states one of its major industries.

2 canned Bartlett pears
2 cream cheese balls
Chopped nuts
Small bunch of grapes, sugared
3 to 4 sections orange
Salad greens
French dressing

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
