Malin won fourth-seeding in the upcoming Klamath County Class B basketball tournament in a 45-39 win over the Henley Hornets last night.

Both teams went into the game with 3-3 records. Malin's win gives the Mustangs fourth place in the league which winds up tonight with Merrill at Chiloquin, Sacred Heart at Bonanza and Bly at Gilchrist.

Chiloquin is favored to finish the season unbeaten with a win over Merrill. Sacred Heart should tie down the second spot in whipping Bonanza.

But should the Mustangs win, Chiloquin will finish second, Malin third, Merrill fourth and Henley fifth. In that event, the Mustangs would have to drop to third.

Malin staged a last-minute comeback to whip Henley last night. Bob Hill, who scored with five minutes to go, scored quickly for Malin and brought the Hornets to points again on two late shots.
