Mexican Film Actress Held

SILVER CITY, N. M. (U-P)—Ro-
saura Revueltas, Mexican film
actress starring in a controversial
movie being made by the Inter-
national Union of Mine, Mill and
Smelter Workers, was arrested
last night.
Immigration officers took her in
custody in the lobby of the hotel
in which she was staying.
Miss Revueltas immediately
claimed the arrest had no basis
and that she entered the country
legally.
She is starring in "Salt of the
Earth," the movie being filmed by
the union with the co-operation of
several Hollywood artists who
have refused to tell congressional
investigators if they were Commu-
nists.
Morris Wright of Denver, editor

of the Mine-Mill newspaper "The
Union," said Miss Revueltas had
acted on the advice of legal coun-
sel in refusing to leave the coun-
try.
Wright said Miss Revueltas
crossed into the United States at
El Paso, Tex., on a bus. She of-
fered to show her passport and
visa, he said, but immigration
officials waved the bus on through.
Later, he said, immigration
agents told her the visa and pas-
port lacked stamps which should
have been put on at the border
and that she would have to leave
the country and reapply for admis-
sion.

tas is starring was condemned
