If lowly Stanford (2-8) should win two from California, UCLA could take the title by winning both from SC. If SC wins both and Cal loses twice, those two teams would tie for the crown. UCLA could tie Cal with a double win while the Bears and Indians split. The well-balanced Bears can make all this figuring worthless by taking two. But Stanford, with ace sharpshooter Ron Tomlin in high gear, could be troublesome.
