

New Soviet Chief Thinks, Acts Quick

Soviet Russia's new boss — Georgi Maximilianovich Malenkov — is a man of action. He showed that in the speed with which he moved into Joseph Stalin's shoes.

For years the chubby, beetle-browed man whom Stalin molded into a model Communist plotted to succeed his boss.

There is little doubt that Malenkov figured some time ago that Stalin's final days were nearing and schemed accordingly.

When the end came he apparently acted swiftly.

His appointment as chairman of the Council of Ministers, the key government job held by Stalin, means that he has firmly grasped one of the real controls of power in the Kremlin and probably has his hands firmly upon others as well.

Malenkov is a product of the Soviet dictatorship Stalin shaped. Only 51, he has known nothing but communism since early adolescence. All his adult life he has spent as a Communist surrounded by Communists.

EDUCATION
Communist teachers and Communist writers have given Malenkov his conception of the Western world and of democracy. These teachings have taught him to be granite-hard, but cautious in his external approach.

The few Western diplomats who have talked to him found him a grim forbidding man who gave one dominant impression — hatred for the Western world.

Rarely seen in public, except on state occasions, Malenkov has seldom been known to relax. Unlike most Russians, who are convivial drinkers and good mixers, Malenkov sips wine and watches the others carouse.

Aping Stalin, he invariably wears the party tunic, buttoned up to the neck, with his trousers tucked in his boots.

His elevation to the prime ministry over the heads of older Bolsheviks did not surprise many observers. His designation last fall as keynote speaker at the 19th party Congress demonstrated clearly that he was recognized as the outstanding figure under Stalin

in both party and government affairs.

STRONG BID

His speech lambasting the party for "mistakes and shortcomings" showed the elements of a successful bidder for his leader's mantle. The tumultuous reception he received from Congress members — second only to that accorded Stalin — showed the position of power he had attained.

Malenkov was born at Orenburg in the Urals in 1902. He was too young to take part when the Russian Revolution broke out, but at 17 he enlisted in the Red Army, and a year later joined the Communist party.

When only 20, he was assigned the job of political commissar — party tutor and spy — in the Army.

In 1925 Stalin got him a job with the Central Committee. He soon became Stalin's personal secretary. In 1937 he was rewarded with a seat on the Central Committee.

Malenkov emerged in a leading

position in party councils just before World War II when he became one of the secretaries of the Central Committee.

ADMINISTRATOR

While Stalin ran the war, Malenkov was in virtual charge of party administration and carried on vital war tasks as well.

He directed aircraft production and by 1943 had boosted it to 46,000 planes a year. For this he received the Soviet Union's highest civilian award, Hero of Socialist Labor. In 1946, he became a full member of the Politburo.

When Malenkov reached his 50th birthday in January, 1952, the Soviet press pulled out all the stops, crying his praises in a manner reminiscent of the fuss made on Stalin's own decade birthdays.

The celebration startled the

Western world and probably a good portion of the Communist world as well. To the West it could mean but one thing — the bright boy who grew up politically under Stalin's wing was being prepared for succession to the crown.

Earlier in the day Gen. Hoyt Vandenberg, air chief of staff, departed from the meeting. Vandenberg also will inspect USAF installations while abroad. Adm. Lynde McCormick, commander of NATO forces in the Atlantic, was scheduled to fly to the meeting from his headquarters at Norfolk, Va.
