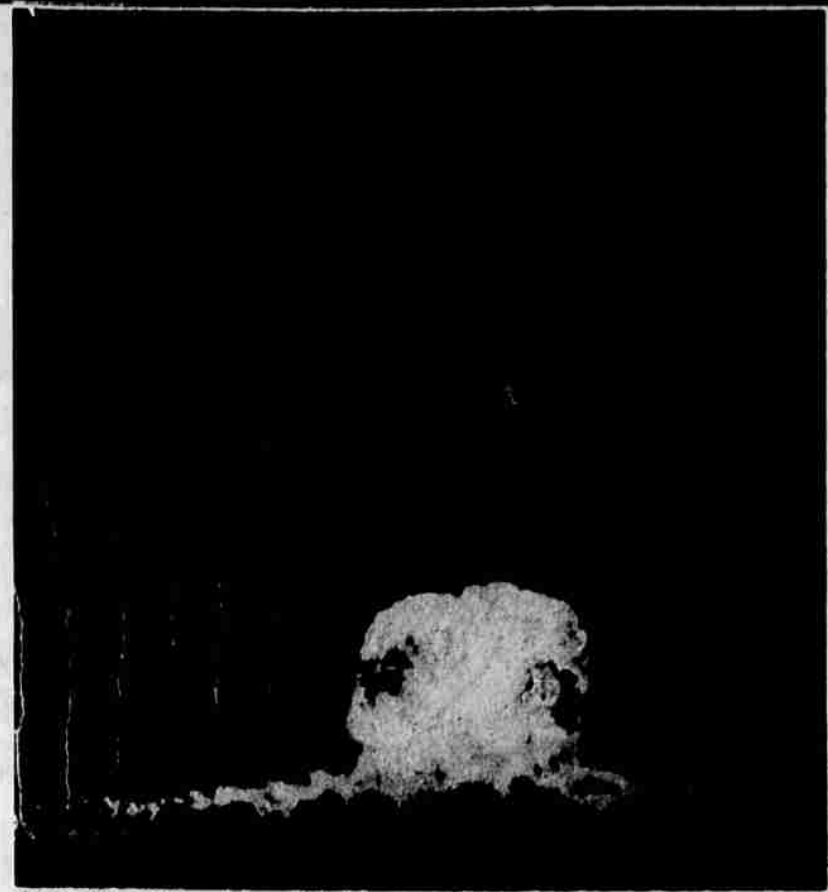

Churchill, Tito Confer On Support

LONDON (N — Prime Minister Churchill called in his top defense and economic advisers today for more talks with President Marshal Tito, Communist boss of Yugoslavia.

It was generally believed that Britain and the anti-Moscow Red dictator were working out assurances—short of a formal treaty—of mutual support in the cold war with the Soviet Union.

The British Foreign Office has given few clues to the scope of the talks but it is known that the problem of Trieste looms large in the attempt to develop closer ties between Tito's Balkan nation and the Western Allies.

Conflicting Yugoslav-Italian claims to sovereignty in the divided "free" territory at the head of the Adriatic Sea thus far have imposed a major roadblock to such efforts.

Before Tito's arrival in London Monday, Foreign Secretary Anthony Eden said Britain hoped "for improved relations between Yugoslavia and Italy — then the West will be truly united."

The first session of the international conference was held Tuesday. As it resumed, Tito was expected to raise the question of economic aid from Britain to his country and perhaps the placing of Yugoslav orders here for modern arms, including jet fighter planes. Tito saw some of Britain's newest jets in action yesterday at an RAF demonstration marked by the death of two pilots in a collision aloft.

Defense Minister Lord Alexander and Chancellor of the Exchequer R. A. Butler were called in to join Churchill and Eden in discussions with Tito and his foreign minister, Koca Popovic.

Tito had a date tonight to dine with members of Parliament at the House of Commons.

Tito, Popovic and a party of 14 were guests at a dinner party given by Churchill last night at No. 10 Downing Street, the Prime Minister's official residence. The 30 British guests included Eden, Butler and Labor Party Leader Clement R. Attlee.

Stevenson Winds Up Japanese Tour

TOKYO (N — Adlai E. Stevenson wound up a 10-day tour of Japan and Korea Thursday with a call on Japan's Emperor Hirohito.

The 1952 U. S. Democratic presidential candidate reported "the emperor and I had a most interesting talk" on Japanese-American relations and the Korean situation.

In the opinion of leading foreign service officers, morale of the career diplomats was lifted by Dulles' strong backing of his selection against the forewarned denunciation by McCarthy and other Republican senators.

Stevenson also visited farms near Tokyo and attended an informal party given by Japanese newspapermen.

He was to depart for Formosa Friday.

Salesman Winds Up Fifty Three Year Tour Of Duty

DUNSMUIR — When Al Meyer, a well known salesman for a San Francisco grocery firm, was in town a few days ago, he was on his last road trip after 53 years of calling on the trade in Southern Oregon and Northern California counties. His tall figure was a familiar one to many old and new residents of this city.

Meyer, a native San Franciscan, has been with his present employers, Haas Brothers, for the past 30 years, spending 17 out of every 21 days on the road.

When asked what his favorite hobby was at home he said, "I like to help my wife, Belle, wash the dishes." They live at 1830 Clay Street in San Francisco.

On his final sales tour, Al was feted at almost every stop by customers and hotel and restaurant men.

Meyer likes to recall the old horse and buggy days at the turn of the century and before the coming of the railroads. It was his custom to rent a horse and buggy for four or five days at a time to cover his territory. During severe winters it was necessary to put snow shoes on the horses.

Prior to his connection with Haas Brothers, Meyer traveled all over California and Southern Oregon with various lines of goods. To

Stact, Humboldt County in these days, he would go by boat from San Francisco to Eureka, and then rent the usual horse and buggy, to get around the county.
