N. N. J. (N) — A tavern owner has admitted killing a 44-year-old man because he stood to see him suffer from cerebral palsy.

He kept an all-night vigil with his son's body in the car. During those hours he chain-smoked a pack of cigarettes, then shredded the butts and smoked the tobacco in his pipe. When this ran out, he ripped apart some cheesecloth and smoked that.

Passaic County Prosecutor Donald Collier said the boy apparently was killed early Saturday night with one shot through the head. An Army carbine was found in the car.

A police check with Bell's physician showed that the tavern owner had been operated on for hemorrhoids but was not in serious condition.

Neighbors, who referred to the boy as "Little Joey," said the Sells were devoted to their son and spared no expense in trying to cure him.
