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Moscow Press Launches Attack On US Race Problem

LONDON (AP) — Moscow's press and radio launched a violent attack Tuesday charging the United States with racial persecution. This was immediately viewed by observers as an attempt to divert Soviet and world attention from the bizarre case of the "doctors' plot," in which there had been implicit admissions of anti-Jewish activity on the part of Soviet officials.

Komsomolskaya Pravda, newspaper of the Soviet Young Communist League, carried a long article concerning what it called "the oppression of Negroes and other racial minority groups in the U. S. A."

Trud, newspaper of the Soviet Trade Union System, said "Rural and American monopolists" by re-militarizing Western Germany were reviving Hitler's forced labor program and "bestial exploitation of the common people," and added that West Germany is now in the grip of famine, poverty and unemployment.

The attacks were broadcast by Moscow Radio, which also carried what it described as a Spanish report on the "lowering of Brazilian workers' standard of living" as a result of the nation's "falling under the aggressive plan of the U. S. imperialists."

This is a familiar Soviet tactic. Often in the past the Soviet propaganda organs have attempted to divert attention from events in the USSR's own sphere by accusing Western nations of precisely the same activities. Having admitted
