

Republican Committee Ready To Okay Hall As Chairman Of Party

Klamath Falls, Ore.—The Republican Committee appeared today to be ready to choose today the choice of a new chairman of the party. The committee is expected to meet at 10 a. m. today at the home of Mrs. J. W. Hall, who served as chairman of the Congressional Campaign Committee before he quit to run for election as a New York state judge, takes over the party's campaign drive. The canvass was a GOP national subcommittee.

Sen. Taft of Ohio, the Republican leader, said one of Hall's first jobs apparently will have to be to help get a fund raising campaign under way.

The Ohio senator, one of those who approved Hall's selection, said he hopes the new chairman picks a Western man as his executive assistant. The name of Wayne Hood, Wisconsin state chairman, was mentioned by some other party members in this connection.

Hall's election seemed likely to inspire a Democratic blast at his record of voting in Congress. The New Yorker traveled on Eisenhower's presidential campaign train and is reported generally in accord with the President's views on major issues.

Democrats already were firing away at Republican claims that they are trimming federal expenses, have stopped the drop in farm prices, are cleaning up subversives in the government and have taken strong steps in foreign policy in their 75 days in office.

Republicans said they already have cut appropriation requests to congress 444 million dollars under former President Truman's estimates. But Sen. Sparkman (D-Ala.) said this was just one of many "falsome claims which are made

without any resemblance to the facts."

Sparkman, the 1952 Democratic vice presidential nominee, said he believes that when Congress has completed its work on the budget, the GOP will have increased the total over Truman's estimates.

In this connection, Sen. Magnuson (D-Wash.) pointed out that Gen. Brownell was asking for nine million dollars more in funds than the Justice Department has in the current year, although his request was seven million under Truman's estimates.

The Democratic National Committee said in a statement that Taft himself had said the Republicans were making slow progress, that the business men chosen for high government posts have no experience in government and that a new program can't be put into effect before July 1.
