Indian Law Study Slated

A Chamber of Commerce Indian Affairs Committee meeting, to consider all aspects of legislation now in process in congress for the purchase of enabling voluntary withdrawal by Indian tribal members, has been called for Friday at 1:30 p.m. at the chamber office. It was announced by Orth Sizemore.

Sizemore, chairman of the Indian Affairs Committee, made the announcement at the chamber directors meeting Wednesday noon, and emphasized that all interested persons are invited to attend.

It was also announced by Mike Balsiger, director in charge of forums, that a forum meeting will be held next Wednesday at 12:00 noon at the Widema banquet room when an official of the Crater Lake National Park will talk on Crater Lake. This year is the 100th anniversary of discovery of the lake. All chamber members and interested persons are invited to attend.

Other chamber business discussed at the meeting was brought up by Lyle Robbenberger, director in charge of industrial development, who told that his committee was planning a visit to a potato processing plant in Caldwell, Idaho; and Bus Larkin, director in charge of visitation, who said that plans are under way for a return visit to the Portland Chamber of Commerce.

Wilson Thesis Said "Finest"

TULELAKE—Proceeds from a small book which includes a thesis written by the late Cadet Hugh Wilson Jr., now nearly ready for publication, will help send a worthy Tulelake high school boy graduate to college.

Clearance for publication has been received from the U. S. Military Academy at West Point where Hugh was a freshman at the time he met death in a plane crash in Arizona, Dec. 30, 1951 after spending Christmas holidays here with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Hugh Wilson, Sr.

The thesis, entitled, "The Causes and Significance of the Modoc War," was rated by the faculty of West Point to have been one of the finest bits of writing ever turned in at the Academy. It received a perfect rating according to Major General P. A. Irving, Superintendent of West Point, who with Rev. Hugh Bronson, Brookings, former pastor of the Tulelake Community Presbyterian church, wrote the introduction.

The idea of the booklet to help raise funds for a scholarship was presented to the High School PTA which agreed to sponsor the project by Mrs. George R. Aiken, member of the Tulelake elementary school board for four years and active in many phases of education.

E. L. Coyner, principal of the high school, W. H. Weitkamp, member of the Siskiyou Joint Union High School Board and Douglas L. Thomas, local business man will serve as a committee to formulate rules and regulations for handling the scholarship.

Purpose of the book is two-fold, it will give in addition to the scholarship, a concise history of the Tulelake area as well as a well-rounded resume of the last Indian War in the locale.
