Federal Men Get Defense

WASHINGTON (AP)—An emergency committee on national defense told President Eisenhower today that government career men should not be removed from their posts to make room for political appointees.

Walter J. Garrison, the committee chairman, told White House officials today that the group set forth that view at a conference with Eisenhower last week.

Garrison, former chief of the Department of Fish and Game, said the President should be urged to say "very much" in favor of strengthening the career service.

Garrison said Eisenhower was not mentioned at the President's denunciation of the M. Day group last week, and that the White House service to assist in the transition were intended to be "short-term."

Samuel H. Hays, chairman of the Senate Resources Council, said the group was interested in finding out "how far the line was going to go" regarding "and where the career service takes over."

Garrison said Eisenhower had a specific comment on the subject.

The President told his news conference last week that if there had been any discharges from the service since he took office, "the reasons, he was completely unaware of it."

Government Drops Suit

WASHINGTON (AP)—The government Tuesday formally dropped a criminal anti-trust proceeding against major oil companies but left the way open to re-instate it later if it decides that should be done.

The criminal action involved charges of a world-wide under-stand by major domestic and foreign companies to control oil distribution and prices.

Leonard J. Emmert, a special assistant to Attorney General Brownell, moved in U. S. District Court to drop the proceeding which was begun during the administration of former President Truman.

Emmert said Brownell wanted to make it clear that a criminal proceeding would be started only if warranted by facts developed in a civil anti-trust proceeding against five big companies.

Judge James R. Kirkland granted Emmert's motion to nullify all actions taken in the criminal anti-trust case. This included the quashing of subpoenas which had been issued for the production of

Boiler Blast Kills Sailors

WASHINGTON (AP)—A boiler explosion on the transport carrier Benjamin Franklin killed 11 enlisted and injured seven others near Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

The Navy said preliminary reports indicated that the explosion caused by a "failure of boiler" in the 27,000 ton carrier's No. 2 boiler.

The Benjamin was under way from a shake-down trading run in the vicinity of the naval base off southern coast of Cuba when the accident occurred.

The injured, six suffered second degree steam burns, the Navy said. The condition of the seventh, similarly injured, was listed as "serious." All of the injured have been moved from the ship to naval hospital at Guantanamo.

The Benjamin was recommissioned at the New York naval yard last Nov. 12. The commanding officer is Capt. D. B. King of Alexandria, Va.

Reports from the ship said damage was "slight." A full investigation is being conducted by the

Police Hold Big Meeting

WASHINGTON (AP)—Selection training of police officers ranks as the most important area for improvement can be made, Oregon Association of City Police Officers was told Monday evening.

Speaker, O. W. Wilson, dean of the school of criminology at the University of California, suggested intelligence tests, psychiatric examinations and through investigation to improve procedures that will assure high average intelligence, emotional stability and high character, those appointed to city police jobs.
