WENDEL, B. C. — The first long term contract in the Columbia lumbering industry was signed here Tuesday. The contract covering 1953-54 was signed by 250 workers, was signed by the International Woodworkers of America and Western Plywood Co. of Caribou, 130 miles from here. The contract calls for a 40-hour week at a rate of \$1.33 an hour plus 10¢ for each hour over 40. The first increase, three cents, goes into effect immediately. ### Northwest Men On List

TOKYO (AP) — The 81 fellow prisoners a Virginia corporal left behind when he was released from a North Korean prison camp included two from the Pacific Northwest.

A list compiled by Col. Everett W. Ritenour, 21, Woodstock, Va., while he was in Red prison camp No. 5 on the Yalu River, was released by the Army Wednesday. Ritenour said the servicemen, all of whom were "in pretty good shape" when he last saw them, wrote their names and addresses in a notebook after the Reds tapped him for repatriation.

Among the still-imprisoned servicemen were Pfc. Ray Stonestor, son of Mr. and Mrs. E. G. Stonestor of Route 2, Box 403, North Side, Ore., and Otho G. Bell, son of Otho G. Bell Sr., Route 5, Box 292, Olympia, Wash. His wife, Jewel, is listed as living at the same address.

Stonestor was reported missing in action Nov. 2, 1950, two months after he arrived in Korea. Later his parents were notified Stonestor was a prisoner.

Bell was fighting with the U. S. Second Division when taken prisoner.

### Farm Plan Outlook Glum

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Aiken (R-Vt.) said Thursday the "chances are not good" that President Eisenhower's plan for reorganization of the Agriculture Department will be approved by Congress.

"It sounds fantastic but good lawyers tell me there is no time limit on the powers granted in his plan, or in many others that Congress has previously approved," said Aiken, chairman of the Senate Agriculture Committee.

"That means that even after the authority granted by Congress to the President to reorganize agencies expires, that cabinet members could continue to reorganize."
