GI Loan Warning Out

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Veterans Administration (VA) said today all veterans who plan to apply for GI loans should apply to VA regional offices in advance for certificates of eligibility.

In the past veterans have been advised to submit their discharge or separation papers to the private lending institution making the loan. The institution then submitted them to the VA on behalf of the veterans.

The change, VA said, will reduce delays in processing loan applications. It said it was necessary because under the Korean GI Bill the VA must have information not previously needed to establish a veteran's eligibility.

Certificates of eligibility are sent to private lenders that VA will guarantee or insure a loan if the veteran meets other usual loan requirements. The change applies to veterans wanting home, farm or business loans.

EUREKA, Calif. (AP) — A general alarm fire fought by more than 100 firemen destroyed the quarter-block Firestone Tire and Rubber Co. store building here Monday, and damaged the Eureka Post office and a medical office building.

Loss of the auto supply and appliance store and stock alone was at more than a half million dollars by Firestone Manager J. J. Brando.

It is hoped that citizens who heretofore have not evidenced interest in such a political organization will take an active part in the promotion of the principles of better government through this club medium.

Elkton-Sutherlin — Paving Cal-

pooya Creek-Sutherlin section, possible delays.

These routes are closed by snow — McKenzie Pass, Mt. Hood Loop, North and East entrances to Crater Lake, Diamond Lake, and Sun Mountain Highways.

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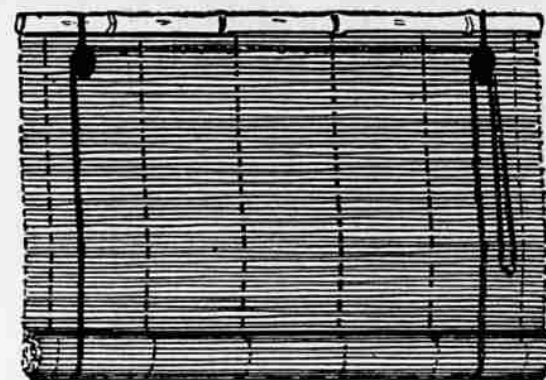
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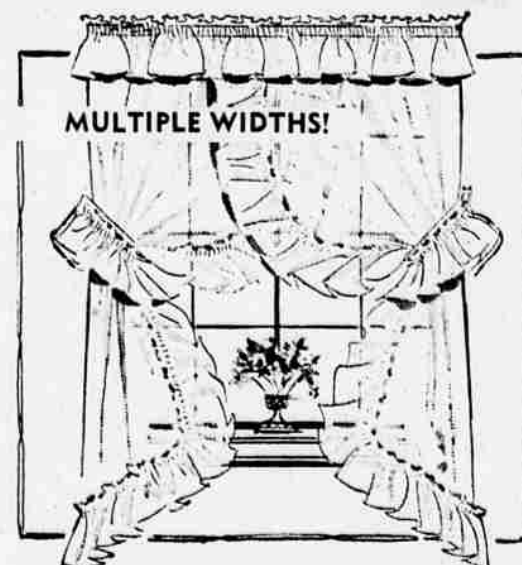
