

### Song Writers, Actors On Stand In Red Trial Today

NEW YORK (AP)—Songwriter Jay Gorney and actor Lionel Stander both refused Wednesday to tell the House Un-American Activities Committee whether they ever had been Communists.

Stander specifically refused to say whether he was a Communist between 1935 and 1948, but he said he was not now a member.

Committee counsel told Gorney that a witness before the committee had identified Gorney and his wife as being members of the Communist Party in Hollywood. He asked if Gorney had been a member there between 1944 and 1948.

Gorney refused to answer, stating it violated his constitutional rights.

He also declined to answer, on constitutional grounds, questions about whether he had knowledge of the Communist Party in Hollywood, whether he ever had been a member, whether he is now one, and whether he would so state if he never had been a party member.

Gorney, who wrote "Brother Can You Spare a Dime" told the committee he discovered Shirley Temple and wrote a song for her called "Baby Take a Bow."

Earlier Chairman Velde (R-Ill.) told the committee a witness had named a number of persons in New York schools as Communists.

The witness, Mrs. Dorothy Funn, Brooklyn Negro teacher, testified Monday she had been a member of a teachers' cell for a number of years.

Velde said Mrs. Funn still is "under the jurisdiction of this committee" and that "any further threat of bodily injury to her will be referred to the FBI for investigation."

A short time before, Lionel Stander, movie actor, declined to tell the committee whether he ever was a Communist Party member between 1935 and 1948. He also said he would decline to answer "anything else you ask me along those lines."

PORTLAND (AP)—Two former Portlanders sent word here Wednesday from London that they were among the 500 rescued from the British ship, Duke of York, which collided with an American transport in the North Sea.

They are Mr. and Mrs. Merrill D. Ely. Ely was a safety engineer with the Army Engineers in Portland for years until transferred to Casablanca in 1951. His wife, who has a number of relatives here, also was with the Army Engineers from 1942 to 1951.

### Police Capture AWOL Soldier

PORTLAND (AP)—A soldier who had been missing for a week and captured Wednesday night in Canada foothills where he was hiding.

When Ted Elliott identified the soldier as Pvt. George S. Siefel, 18, Elliott said he had been in the Portland Air Corps stockade a week ago, and had stolen five cars and a plane. A charge of desertion was pending on each. Elliott said he spotted Siefel driving a road 14 miles east of Portland. When Siefel ignored his signals, Elliott said he fired his rifle. Two of them hit Siefel in the right arm. He was taken to a base hospital under armed guard.
