Sentences Vary Widely In Case Of Drive-In Robbery

Dame Justice must have peeked from beneath her blindfold of "equality to all" here last week. Because of good dame's temporary fickleness, a confessed thief has gotten off with a far lighter sentence than three companions whose crimes were of a much lesser nature.

Early last Friday morning, City Police and Great Northern Special Agent Hagan Moore raided a hobo camp and recovered a large quantity of foodstuffs stolen a few hours earlier from Duke's Drive Inn, 1515 S. 6th.

Five persons, one of them a 14-year-old boy, were arrested. The youth was turned over to juvenile authorities and released a short while later to return to his home in suburban Detroit, Mich.

Four men arrested with the youth were: James Jenkins, 29, Cameron, N.C.; Robert Morrow, 32, Holtville, Calif.; Winnell Harris, 29, Ferndale, Mich.; and Carroll Gustin, 22, Dalhart, Texas.

Gustin signed a statement at City Police headquarters admitting he had broken into Duke's Drive Inn and made off with a ham, four T-bone steaks, block of cheese and three loaves of bread. He said none of the other three men had anything to do with the theft.

The other three, Jenkins, Morrow and Harris, were charged with vagrancy and Acting Municipal Judge J. C. Hunt sentenced each of them to 30 days in jail and \$100 fines. If the men don't pay the fines, and apparently they can't, they will each have to serve a total of 60 days in jail.

Gustin, the confessed burglar, was turned over to the county. The district attorney's office decided to charge Gustin only with vagrancy instead of burglary.

And Acting District Judge Ben Goddard decided to sentence Gustin to County Jail for 15 days.

Dist. Atty. Frank Alderson said late this morning he might see the Duke's Drive Inn management about signing another complaint against Gustin. This new complaint would be for petit larceny, Alderson said.

Students voting today in the city county school budget elections requested to know the number of precinct when they visit polls. School authorities said would greatly speed voting.

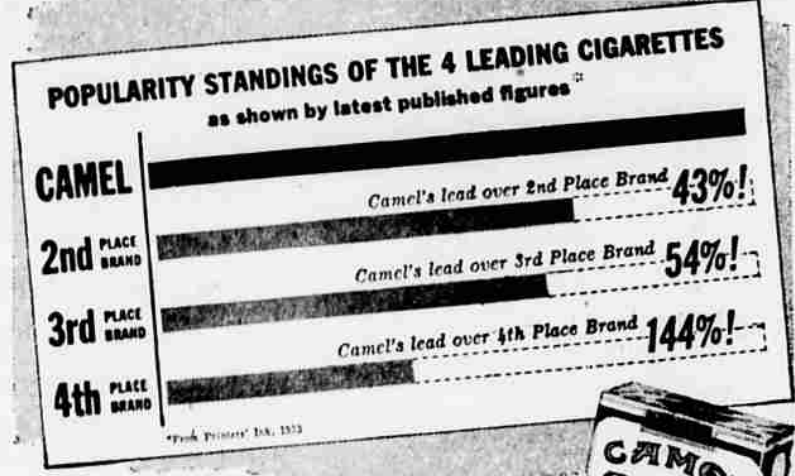
County schools budget voting is being held at Fremont school on elementary schools budget and at Smith Union High School on high school budget.
