## Money Urged For Forest Projects

WASHINGTON, May 14 (AP) - The Portland Chamber of Commerce is urging Congress to approve an \$800,000 appropriation for development of recreational facilities in the forests.

The last large development of such facilities was back in the days of the Civilian Conservation Corps, said H. B. Bay, Washington manager of the Portland Chamber of Commerce, told a House subcommittee in testimony made public Wednesday.

He said such development would be a substantial factor in the economy of the U. S.

"Essential as it is to the government's outlay of money, we believe it would be poor economy to refuse the considered request of forestry officials in the Agricultural Appropriations Bill," he said.
