

Fishing Loss for Tribes Payment OK

WASHINGTON (AP) — Secretary of the Interior, Harold Ickes, Monday announced approval of a contract calling for payment of \$2,245,000 to the Warm Springs and Umatilla tribes in Oregon, subject to annual approval, for loss of fishing rights resulting from construction of the Dalles Dam.

The contract is between the tribes and the Army Engineers building the dam on the Snake River. The Umatilla tribe is claiming a loss of \$1,000,000 and the Warm Springs Indians are claiming \$1,245,000. There are 2,500 Umatilla Indians and 1,500 Warm Springs Indians living in the area.

Census Form Simplified

A revised application form for use of persons seeking to establish proof of age or citizenship through personal census records is now available at the Census Bureau's district office in Sacramento, Calif., according to District Supervisor Jack W. Travers Jr.

The revised form is designed to encourage applicants to use the censuses of 1880, 1900 and 1920, if possible, when requesting search of the voluminous census records. Officials point out that information from these censuses can be furnished more rapidly because the records for these years have been card indexed. Because of the comprehensive index, information can be provided in most instances if the applicant furnishes only his name, the name of the city or county and State in which he was living and the name of the head of the household in which he was re-

siding. Searches of the card index of these censuses can be conducted five times faster than by the conventional method of looking through the original records.

Persons holding information from the censuses of 1910, 1930, 1940 and 1950—if residing in a city at the time these censuses were taken—should furnish the house number, name of the street, city, county and State, and the name of the parent or head of the household with whom living.

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FBI Adds Man To Top List

WASHINGTON (AP) — The FBI Monday put Robert Current, 29-year-old west coast bandit, on its list of "10 most wanted fugitives."

The announcement said the slenderly-built Current is reported to have a serious tubercular condition and "has adopted the attitude that he has nothing to live for and will shoot anyone attempting to apprehend him."

Current's criminal record goes back 10 years to a burglary conviction in Oakland, Calif., for which he served nine months. He has since been involved in holdups in Minneapolis, St. Paul and on the West Coast.

The FBI said that at St. Paul last March 1 he and two companions raided the offices of a large dairy company, held 23 employees at gunpoint and fled with \$24,000.

He is also sought for a grocery store robbery at Stockton, Calif., last Sept. 17, and an assault on a woman bookkeeper on a San Francisco street last Jan. 26 when he and an accomplice snatched two canvas bags containing about \$1,500 from her hands.

Current, a native of Yamhill, Ore., is 5-foot-8 and weighs about 127 pounds. Black-haired, he has a fair complexion and brown eyes.

House Membership Cut By Hull Death

WASHINGTON (AP) — The death of Rep. Hull (R-Wis.), cut the House membership to 431.

Hull, who died Sunday in Wisconsin, was the first Republican fatality of the 83rd Congress. His death cut the Republican membership in the House to 220.

The present House line-up: Republicans, 220; Democrats, 210; Independent one; Vacancies, four.

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
