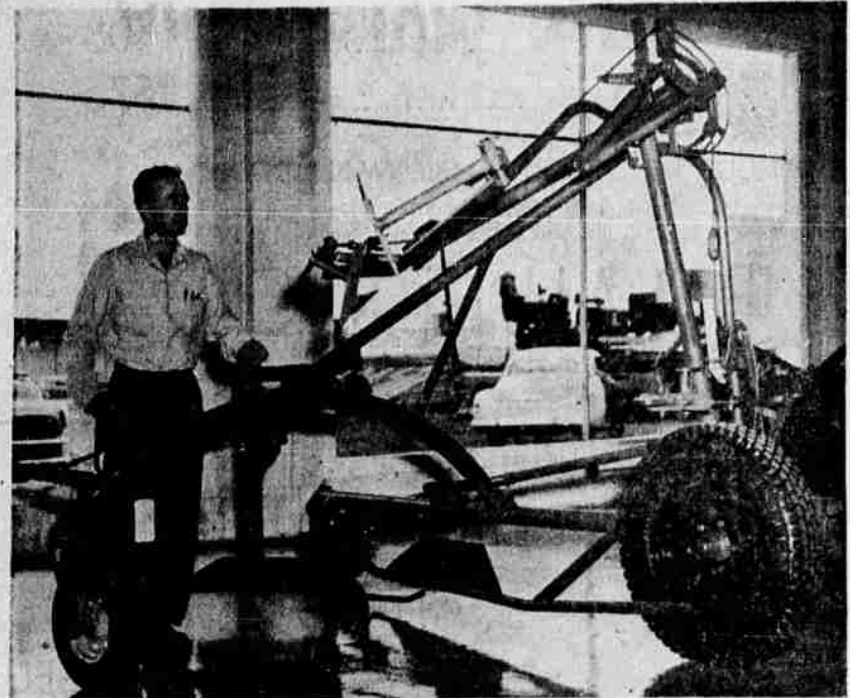

Strawberries Pour In; Prices Fall Off

PORTLAND (P) — Strawberries poured into the market early Tuesday and the price fell off 50 cents to \$1.00 a flat.

Some early sales of fancy packs went at \$3 to \$3.25 a flat but the bulk of the trading was at \$2.50-\$2.75. A sizable lot went at \$2.25 and below.

There are a dozen boxes to a flat.

FARE HIKED

SALEM (P) — Public Utilities Commissioner Charles H. Helms authorized the Portland Traction Company Tuesday to increase the fares on the Portland-Oregon City route.

The increase for single trips is five cents, and the boost on commutation fares is six cents a single trip.

Burton Hutton, state 4-H leader who will accompany the group, said they will meet President Eisenhower and Oregon's congressmen, sit in on Congressional meetings, visit historic shrines and ride on the Potomac.

Miss Bohnert and Gardner, both 19, have made their marks in livestock. Miss Bradshaw, also 19, has carried major projects in cooking and sewing. Belton, 18, has won top honors in dairying.

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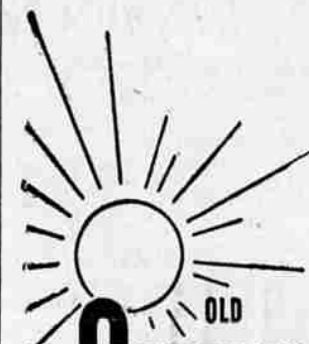
